**Subject: Recruitment of 5 Consultants for RIEs in the Department of Elementary Education through the Early Literacy Programme in NCERT.**

The Department of Elementary Education (DEE) is a nodal department of NCERT to advise the Government of India on policies and programmes pertaining to elementary education in formal and Alternative Innovative Education Sector at the national level. It also acts as a nodal centre at the national level for the implementation of SSA and RTE Act 2009. Under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, the Early Literacy Programme works for developing an understanding of the process of reading and writing. The Early Literacy Programme has developed teacher's manuals on early literacy, conducts training programmes, publishes children's magazine and works towards promotion of a culture of reading. The programme supports states and union territories to understand and strengthen the pedagogy of reading and writing in the foundation years of schooling.

The Early Literacy Programme requires the following academic project staff on contract basis for a specific period. The selected person will be engaged initially upto 31/3/2014 which may be extendable from time to time on the basis of performance till on co-termination of the project. As this is a time bound project and the work is to be accomplished within the limited period, eligible candidates who can join immediately after selection should appear for **walk-in interview**. ### **Qualification**

### **Job Profile**

1. The candidate will support in implementing the Early Literacy Programme in states and union territories and activities of the Department of Elementary Education. He/She will be required to conduct research and organize/co-ordinate teachers training programmes in the area of early literacy.
2. The newly appointed Consultants will be required to attend two months orientation about the objectives/activities and functioning of the Early Literacy Programme at the Apex level as well as in the respective states.
3. After completion of their two month orientation, they will report to the Principal of respective RIE.
4. In these two months the Consultants will support NIE team in planning meetings of the Early Literacy Programme in States and union territories and also conduct orientation programmes at State level.
5. At the RIEs they would work in close cooperation with the committee constituted for Early Literacy Programme by the principal of respective RIE.
6. The selected candidates will be provided one time to and fro 3<sup>rd</sup> AC train fare from their place of posting to Delhi and back.
7. The selected candidates may stay at the NIE Guest House during the period of orientation and expenditure on their stay food may be met from the SSA funds.
