B. Scale of Pay: Pay Band Rs. 15600-39100/- and Grade Pay Rs. 5400/-.

In addition to Pay they will also be eligible for DA, NPA, HRA and Transport Allowance as per rules in force from time to time.

C. Age Limit: Not exceeding 30 years as on <u>07.10.2013</u>. Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for employees of ESI Corporation and Government servants in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Govt. Upper age limit is also relaxable to SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Ex-Servicemen & other categories of persons as per rules/instructions of Govt. of India.

D. Essential Qualifications:

- A recognized medical qualification included in the first or second Schedule or Part-II
 of third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council
 Act, 1956. Holders of educational qualification included in Part-II of the Third
 Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in Sub-Section (3) of Section 13
 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.
- 2. Completion of Compulsory rotating internship.**
- 3. <u>Language test</u>: The candidate shall have to pass a qualifying test of middle standard in official language of the State concerned where the vacancies are notified.
- 4. Registration with the Medical Council of India.

NOTE I:**Candidates who have not completed rotating internship shall be eligible to appear for the written examination provided that, if selected, they shall satisfactorily complete the compulsory rotating internship before appointment.

- F. The following testimonials should be attached with application form:

- (a) One copy of self-attested recent passport size photograph pasted on the application form.
- (b) Self-attested copies of certificates and testimonials in support of proof of age (Date of Birth), Educational qualification, Attempts Status, Compulsory Rotating Internship and Experience etc.
- (c) Self-attested copy of Community Status Certificate in the prescribed form in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH/Ex.- Serviceman category. Candidates claiming reservation/ age relaxation on grounds of belonging to OBC should submit the self-attested copy of Community Certificate in Annexure -"A" prescribed vide Govt. of India, Department of Personal and Training OM No. 36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 15.11.93 along with self-declaration given in Annexure 'B' failing which the benefit of reservation and age relaxation will not be given.

Those candidates who are employed in Govt./Semi Govt. /Autonomous bodies etc. should sent their system generated hard copy of online application "<u>Through Proper Channel</u>". However, they may send an <u>advance copy</u> of their <u>system generated hard copy of online application</u> alongwith demand draft and other certificates and testimonials before the last date.

<u>Note</u> 1:- The <u>system generated hard copy of application</u> and the other documents should be arranged in the following order one below the other and tightly tagged or stapled on the left hand side top corner:

- 1. Application Form.
- 2. Self-attested copies of certificates.

Note 2:-The Demand Draft should not be tagged or stapled, but should be pinned or clipped at the top of the application form. The name and address of the candidates should be written on the reverse side of the Demand Draft.

G. <u>General conditions</u>:-

- 01. Mere submission of application does not confer any right to be called for written test.
- 02. A candidate should submit one application only.

The Written Examination for all the above States shall be conducted on same date. As such candidates are advised to apply for any one of the above States for which vacancies are advertised.

- 03. Only system generated hard copy of online application with unique serial number (through website of ESIC at www.esic.nic.in) should be submitted along with other documents up to 14.10.2013. Candidates can generate / submit their online application up to 07.10.2013 (before 5.00 PM). The link of making online application will not be available after 05.00 PM on 07.10.2013.
- 04. Incomplete or unsigned application or applications received without self-attested copies of certificates of educational qualification, caste certificate, and photograph and those received after the last date for receipt of applications are liable to be rejected without any communication to the candidate.

H. Mode of Selection:-

(a) The selection for the post of Insurance Medical Officer Grade-II will be made on the basis of Written Examination [Part – I - Objective Test (to assess professional knowledge) and Part – II - Descriptive Test in Official Language (which will be of qualifying nature) of the state concerned where the candidate wants to apply.

The candidates qualifying in Part –I Objective Test and Part – II Descriptive Test in Official Language will be considered for shortlisting for interview on the basis of their performance in Part – I Objective Test.

The qualifying marks in Part – I Objective Test and Part – II Descriptive Test in Official Language shall be decided by ESI Corporation.

(b) Centre of Examination: The written examination and interviews for above States shall be conducted preferably at State Capital of the concerned State. No request for change of examination centre shall be entertained. However ESIC reserves the right to change the examination centre, if need be.

No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate including SC/ST candidates for appearing in the written test.

Note 1: Number of vacancies can vary at the time of selection.

Note 2: The selected candidates will be kept posted and transferred anywhere in the State chosen in the Pay Band Rs. 15600-39100/- and Grade Pay Rs. 5400/- in the respective cadre, as far as possible, but they are liable to be posted anywhere in India.

Note 3: The interview for the post of IMO Grade-II will be held at a suitable place in the respective State which will be notified at the time of calling for interviews. The Corporation, however, reserves its right to change the venue of Interview in the event of inadequate number of candidates available for interview in a particular venue.

Note 4: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date of submission of online application from candidates in india i.e. 07.10.2013 (and not the closing date of receipt of hard copies of applications from candidates including closing date of receipt of hard copies of applications prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep).
