NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited from qualified Indian Citizens for appointment to the post of Translator in the High Court of Kerala. Applications should be submitted in the prescribed format which is available in the website (www.highcourtofkerala.nic.in) and notice board of the High Court. Applications in the prescribed format prepared on good quality A4 size paper in accordance with the instructions in this notification should be sent to the High Court by post.

1. **Recruitment No:** 7/2013
2. **Name of the post:** Translator.
3. **Scale of pay:** ₹ 13900 – 24040
4. **Number of vacancies:** 1(One). Vacancies that may arise during the period of validity of the ranked list shall also be filled up from the list. The ranked list prepared pursuant to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of two years from the date on which it is brought into force and shall continue to remain in force until the publication of a fresh list or till the expiry of three years, whichever is earlier.
5. **Method of appointment:** Direct Recruitment.
6. **Mode of Selection:** The selection will be on the basis of Translation Test (translation from Malayalam into English and vice versa) and Interview.
7. **Age limit:** Candidates should have been born between 02.01.1977 and 01.01.1995 (both days inclusive). Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates should have been born between 02.01.1972 and 01.01.1995 (both days inclusive). Other Backward Classes Candidates should have been born between 02.01.1974 and 01.01.1995 (both days inclusive).
A candidate who is an Ex- serviceman or Ex-general Reserve Engineer Force person or a disembodied Territorial Army person, in reckoning the age for his eligibility for appointment, can exclude the period of his service in the defence forces or in the General Reserve Engineer Force or in the Territorial Army, as the case may be, and the period of unemployment on discharge up to a maximum of five years provided that he has not completed the age of 50 years.
8. **Qualification:** Bachelor's degree in any subject awarded or recognised by any of the Universities in Kerala with not less than second class for the optional subject. In the case of SC/ST candidates, holders of Bachelor's degree in the third class are also qualified to apply. The candidates appointed to the service will have to acquire the following qualifications within the period of probation:
 - 1.High Court Office Procedure Test
 - 2.Account Test (Lower)
 - 3.Judicial Test or Civil Judicial Test and Criminal Judicial Test (Law Graduates are exempted from passing this test)".
9. **Application fee:** ₹ 250/-. SC/ST and Unemployed Physically Handicapped candidates are exempted from payment of fee. The fee should be remitted by way of Demand Draft drawn from any of the Nationalised Banks in favour of "Registrar

General, High Court of Kerala” payable at Ernakulam. The candidates should write their name and address on the reverse of the Demand Draft and send it along with the filled in application. Fee once paid will not, in any case, be refunded.

10. Appointment to the post from the Ranked List prepared as per this notification will be made in accordance with rules of reservation prescribed in Rules 14 to 17 of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 and in accordance with the rules made for the purpose from time to time.
11. The candidates should have acquired the qualification prescribed on or before the last date fixed for receipt of applications. Candidates possessing degrees which are not awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala should obtain certificate of recognition of their degrees from any of the Universities in Kerala and keep it with them. The certificate of recognition of the degree should be produced as and when called for, failure of which will entail cancellation of candidature.
12. Candidates should send along with the application self attested copies of Degree certificates/documents to prove their qualification. Mark lists will not be accepted as proof of qualifications. Applications not accompanied by proof of qualification will be rejected.
13. Documents to prove age, community, Non Creamy Layer status, claim for exemption from payment of application fee etc. should be produced as and when called for.
14. Candidates should affix their passport size photograph (taken within the last 6 months) at the space provided for in the application form and sign across it. Applications received without signature on the photograph affixed will be rejected.
15. While applying, candidates who are in the service of the Government of India or any of the State Governments should obtain No Objection Certificate from their Head of Office or Department and keep it with them. If the candidate fails to produce the No Objection Certificate as and when called for, his/her candidature will stand cancelled.
16. The candidate should ensure that the particulars furnished by him/her are correct in all respects. In case it is detected at any stage of recruitment that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility norms and/or that he/she has furnished any incorrect/false information or has suppressed any material facts, his/her candidature will stand cancelled. If any of these shortcomings is detected even after appointment, his/her service is liable to be terminated.
17. The envelope containing the application shall be superscribed “Application for the post of Translator” and sent to “THE REGISTRAR GENERAL, HIGH COURT OF KERALA, ERNAKULAM, KOCHI-682 031”.
18. Applications which are not in accordance with this notification and received after the last date prescribed shall be summarily rejected.
