GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- The number of posts indicated above is tentative, which may increase or decrease.
- 2. These posts are Non-Government, but pension able under new pension rules effective from **01-01-2004** and service conditions are mutatis mutandis as applicable to Indian Council of Agricultural Research employees.
- 3. The posts are temporary but likely to continue and the candidate may be transferred to anywhere in India.
- **4.** Crucial date for determining the Age Limit of candidates for the post shall be as **on 18 November 2013.**
- 5. Persons already in Employment should route their applications through proper channel only. In case a candidate anticipates any delay in forwarding of his/her application through proper channel, he/she must send an advance copy of the application, which must reach this office on or before closing date, but at the same time he/she may ensure that the original application is forwarded by their employer and must reach to this office latest by 30th November, 2013 failing which his/her candidature shall not be considered and no correspondence to this effect shall be entertained.
- 6. The qualification prescribed is the minimum required for the post and enhanced qualification does not entitle candidates to be called for interview/aptitude test. Where the number of applications received in response to advertisement is large, it will not be convenient OR possible for the Institute to call all the candidates for interview/aptitude test. The Director, NCIPM, New Delhi reserves the right to fix the criteria for calling the candidates for interview/aptitude test on the basis of qualifications, experience, etc. After screening the applications the candidates will be called for written test/Interview/skill test at NCIPM, New Delhi. Candidates for LDC posts, who qualify the written test, will only be called for Typing Test. NO change of Examination Centre will be considered.
- 7. Applications should be submitted strictly in the prescribed Performa. The Performa on www.ncipm.org.in (neatly typed on computer). Candidates, before applying for the post, must satisfy that they are eligible to apply and fulfil the criteria/essential qualification, age, etc. as prescribed for the post along with attested copies of the relevant documents such as Educational qualifications/Age/Caste Certificate, etc. If any information furnished by the candidate is found false at any stage his/her candidature will be forfeited.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION: The examination will consist of a written examination and Typing Test for the post of Lower Division Clerks.

(A) SCHEME OF THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION AND SYLLABUS

The written examination will consist of one objective type paper as shown below:

<u>NOTE-I:</u> The paper will consist of Objective Type-Multiple Choice questions only. The questions will be set both in English & Hindi.

NOTE-11: There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

SYLLABUS

General Intelligence: It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. The test will include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discriminating observation, relationship concepts, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidates' abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

English Language: In addition to the testing of candidates' understanding of the English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. his/her writing ability would also be tested.

Numerical Aptitude: This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion. Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, blensuration. Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

NOTE: For VH candidates of 40% and above visual disability and opting for SCRIBE there will be no component of Maps/Graphs/Diagrams/Statistical Data in the General Intelligence & Reasoning: General Awareness Paper.

(B) Skill Test for LDCs: (Skill Test will be taken on Computer)

Typing Test will be of Qualifying in nature.

English Typing @ 35 w.p.m. (Time allowed 10 minutes) (30 minutes for VH candidates) Hindi Typing @ 30 w.p.m. (Time allowed 10 minutes) (30 minutes for VH candidates)
