#### **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

- DATE OF BIRTH BLOCK. (a) 31 MAY 1997 (both days inclu m between 01 FEBRUARY 1994 to 11.
- (b) Upper age limit on date of enrolment is 21 years.

#### **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION**

(a) Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English, with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English. OR

(b) Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology /Information Technology from a Government recognised Polytechnic Institute with minimum 30% marks in overall aggregate, and 50% marks in English in Diploma or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma

Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic Training Institute, Belgaum (Kamataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for Trade Training of specified duration. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainer falls to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit. After successful completion of training, the airmen will be deployed on ground based jobs as per their allotted trades.

Group 'X' (Technical) Trades involve jobs as given below:

(a) Automobile Fitter. In this trade you are responsible for maintenance and repair of all types of light and heavy duty mechanical vehicles, cranes and loading equipment etc. (b) Electronics Fitter. As a Electronics Fitter you operate and maintain Radar, Voice and Data transmission and reception equipment mounted on latest airborne wapon delivery systems and ground based air defence systems. You will get trained in Digital Electronics, measuring instruments, radar technology, latest electronic devices and related trade fundamentals. (c) Electrical Fitter. You will maintain devices and related trade fundamentals. (c) Electrical Fitter. You will maintain ground systems. You will also maintain photo equipment mounted on air borne weapon systems and operate ground based photo systems. You will get trained in electrical trade, operation and maintenance of digital devices, electronics devices etc. (d) Mechanical System Fitter. You will epic air and maintain mechanical, hydrolic equipment. Complete aircraft fuelling equipment. Complete aircraft ground supsort equipment will also be repaired and maintained by you. You will be trained in handling and preparation of bombs and explosives and in electrical ground supsort equipment will also be repaired and maintained by you. You will be trained in handling and preparation of bombs and explosives and in electrical system, workshop and mechanical trades as well as automobile mechanics. (e) Structures Fitter, As Structures Fitter you are responsible for the maintenance and servicing of airtranse and their accessories, components and controls of aircraft. ## SELECTION PROCEDURE

## SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

Results of the written test will be declared on the same day.
