UR - Unreserved, OBC - Other Backward Class (Non-creamy layer), SC-Scheduled Caste, ST - Scheduled Tribe, Ex-S - Exserviceman, LV - Low Vision, HI - Hearing Impaired, LM - Loco-motor.

As per Company policy, the vacancies are partially earmarked for being filled through dependents of BHEL deceased employees on compassionate grounds. In case these vacancies are not filled up due to non-availability of qualified candidates, they may also be filled through open selection.

The reservations will be as per the extant Government Rules/Act. The vacancies for ex-servicemen and persons with disability will be filled and adjusted in the appropriate category viz., UR/OBC/SC/ST on horizontal basis.

Note: The number of vacancies is tentative and hence the reserved vacancies status is only indicative. The number of reserved vacancies in each category may undergo revision in that eventuality.

- Vacancies for OBC category are meant only for those coming under the 'non-creamy layer'. 'Non-Creamy Layer' under the OBC means 'the gross annual income of parents of the candidate should not be more than Rs. 4.5 lakhs in the last three consecutive years'. The OBC candidates who do not belong to Non Creamy Layer should indicate their category as 'General' only.
- Persons with not less than 40% of the relevant disability shall alone be eligible for the benefit of reservation. The definition of Low Vision, Locomotor Disability & Hearing Impairment for persons with disability is as per "The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities-Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995.
- The Physically challenged candidates are required to furnish stamped Medical Certificate in relation to their disability from a Government Hospital or Medical Board attached to Special Employment Exchange for the handicap.
- Candidates belonging to SC/ST categories and Persons with disability are exempted from paying the examination fee.
- Upper age limit is relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and by 3 years for OBC candidates. In respect of 'Persons with disability the age limit is relaxed by 10 years for General category, 13 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) and 15 years for SC/ST category. All ex-servicemen will be allowed age relaxation to the extent of their service plus 3 years (6 years in the case of OBC and 8 years for SC/ST).
- Upper age is relaxed by 5 years for the candidates who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01/01/1980 to 31/12/1989.
- Upper age limit is further relaxed up to 84 months for candidates possessing relevant experience of working with an employer/organization engaged in the manufacturing, assembly, testing and servicing of power plant equipment. The candidates who are engaged through the contractors directly in these operations would also be entitled to the age relaxation. $This age \ relaxation \ is available \ to candidates \ having \ a foresaid \ experience \ of \ at-least \ 50 \ months \ of \ continuous \ or \ intermittent$ service for availing 7 years of relaxation and on pro-rata basis for less than 7 years of relaxation. For claiming age relaxation, experience certificate from the employer/organization is required to be produced with details of period of working, field of experience and nature of products manufactured/services rendered by the organization. Such candidates will have to compete with other eligible candidates in the Written Test/Interview etc. The decision of BHEL regarding authenticity/genuineness of experience certificates and relevance of experience shall be final and binding.
- A one-time relaxation in Upper Age limit and exemption in payment of examination fee will be extended to those candidates who appeared in the written examination conducted on 14.02.2010 against our Advertisement No.02/2009. While submitting their application on-line, these candidates have to necessarily indicate the earlier roll number to be eligible for the age relaxation, for which there is a system check. The earlier roll number can be retrieved on-line by furnishing relevant information or ascertained through the Help Desk on telephone Nos.040-23183587, 040-23184247 which will be operative from 08.30 hours to 16.00 hours on all working days till the last date of submission of the on-line applications.
- Upper age is relaxed further by 5 years for deceased employee dependents. For the dependents of the deceased employees, the cut-off date for computation of upper age limit will be taken as 01.10.2009. A separate written test will be conducted and a separate panel will be prepared for them.

EMOLUMENTS AND BENEFITS:

- The selected candidates will initially work as Temporary Employees (Artisan) for a period of one year. In addition, the selected candidates will be required to undergo specific training, if any, depending upon the requirement during the period as Temporary Employee (Artisan). The absorption in the regular establishment will be based on review of their performance/behavior/suitability to remain in the services of the Organisation as assessed by the Committee constituted for this purpose. During the period of one year, they will be paid a consolidated wage of Rs.11,000/- per month
- On successful completion of this period, they will be regularized in the establishment as ARTISAN GRADE-IV and placed at the minimum of the sale of pay of Rs.11700-23000/- with applicable allowances in vogue at the time of regularization.

PREFERENCE FOR BEST/RUNNER UP APPRENTICE:

Preference is given for BEST Apprentice/ RUNNER UP Apprentice at All India SKILL Competitions conducted by the Directorate General of Employment and Training. These candidates who were/are selected as BEST APPRENTICE or RUNNER UP APPRENTICE in the All India SKILL Test, will be required to apply online and submit their application as per the procedure. They will, however, be exempted from appearing at the written test and they shall be directly called for interview subject to fulfilling other terms and conditions and eligibility criteria. In the event of their selection, Best Apprentice will be inducted as Artisan Gr.IV with 2 increments and Runner-up Apprentice will be inducted as Artisan Gr.IV at the minimum of the scale in the pay scale of Rs.11700-23000/-.

HEALTH STANDARDS:

- Applicant should have sound health. Before joining, selected candidates will have to undergo medical examination by the Company's Authorized Medical Officer and the appointment will be subject to meeting the health standards prescribed by the
- The candidates are advised in their own interest to get themselves thoroughly examined by a competent Medical Officer

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Selection process shall consist of Written Test and Interview. The Written Test will be conducted on Sunday, 10/11/2013 (Tentative).
- All eligible candidates shall be invited for an objective type Written Test to be conducted at Hyderabad, details of which shall be communicated in the candidate's Permission Slip / Admit card.
- The Written test shall be tri-lingual; in English/Hindi/Telugu languages
- On the basis of merit of Written Test marks, candidates shall be invited for Personal Interview in the ratio of 1:3 to the number of vacancies.
- For applying the above ratio, initially, all UR candidates of each trade, along with such reserved category candidates of that trade, who do not avail any relaxation, are to be grouped together and then arranged in descending order of written test marks to be called for interview in the ratio of 1:3 in UR category. After this, candidates belonging to OBC/SC/ST categories, who are not short listed for interview as UR, shall be regrouped with their respective categories for further consideration and candidates will be called in the prescribed ratio of 1:3 for interview for each category. The same procedure shall apply at the time of final selection

- All eligible Ex-Serviceman candidates who possess the pass certificate in NTC/NAC or equivalent (% of marks not mandatory) in the relevant trade shall be called for written test.
- All Ex-servicemen shall produce Certificates / Documents in proof of their qualification/trade proficiency being equivalent to NTC/NAC issued by the Armed forces at the time of interview.
- All departmental candidates (BHEL employees) applying for the post/s and possessing the requisite qualification shall be called for written test.
