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**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE**  
**(For the Students Studying in Class X)**

1. Make sure that the Admit Card is not detached from the application form. Candidate can collect the Admit Card from the respective District Inspector of Schools (S.E.) **at least one week** before the examination.
2. Reach the Examination Center at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take calculator, mathematical and physical table or any other kind of ready reckoner to the Examination Hall.
4. The examination will be conducted in two sessions on the same day.
5. You have to take the examination in TWO PARTS:
  - (i) Part I: Part I is confined to Mental Ability Test (MAT) and Language Comprehensive Test.
  - (ii) Part II: Part II is confined to Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) consisting of questions from Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, History, Geography, Pol.Sc., Economics.
6. **Time for Part I is 90 minutes (11 am to 12:30 pm) and for Part II is 90 minutes (1 pm to 2:30 pm)**
7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
8. Write your name and Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the Answer Sheet and only Roll No. on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
9. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question FOUR possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
10. Record your answer using Ball Point PEN only. You have to indicate your answer on the Answer Sheet as advised by the State/UT.
11. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
12. **Hand over your Answer Sheet only to the Invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.**
13. **Hand over the admission card to the Invigilator before leaving the Examination Hall.**
14. Please enclose certificate issued by the competent authority in support of SC/ST/Physically Disabled candidate along with the application form. Otherwise, he/she will be treated as general candidate in case of selection.
