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1. INTRODUCTION

All India Post Graduate Ayurved Entrance Test 2013 ([AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#)) will be conducted for admissions to various Post Graduate Ayurved Courses (MD/MS, Ayurved Vachaspati /Ayurved Dhanvantari) conducted at Dr. D. Y. Patil College of Ayurved & Research Institute, Nerul, Navi Mumbai 400 706, a constituent college of Padmashree Dr. D.Y. Patil University on **10/10/2013 from 11.30am to 2.30pm.**

The College was established in Oct. 2004 and is recognized by the Government of Maharashtra, Central Council of Indian Medicine & Dept. of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & family welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi, UGC & NAAC.

The College is associated with a 168-bed teaching hospital in its campus having state of the art facilities for health care and treatment.

The Admission Committee of the University will be responsible for conduct of the entrance test, declaration of results, counseling and final admission to the courses.

2. COURSES

- 2.1** The PG Ayurved Courses (MD/MS Ayurved Vachaspati/ Ayurved Dhanvantri) in following subjects are available at Dr. D.Y. Patil College of Ayurved & Research Institute, Nerul, Navi Mumbai :

- 2.2** Courses are approved from Government of Maharashtra, Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi & Dept. of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & family welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi for last two academic years 2011-12 & 13. Admissions to these courses will also be based on the performance of the candidates at the [AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#). Admission/s for the PG courses will be subject to permission of Dept. AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India for the year 2013-14.

- 2.3 a. General Category:** 50% seats are reserved for General Category. Admission to this category will be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates at [AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#).

b. Management Seats: 50% of the seats are reserved for Management quota. Admission to this category will also be made on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates at [AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#).

3. MODE OF ENTRANCE TEST

3.1 The [AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#) will be of three hours duration containing 200 multiple choice questions (MCQs). Questions will be of single best response objective type with four answer options. Each correct answer will be awarded one mark. There shall be no negative marking for incorrect answers.

3.2 The Examinations will be conducted in **English**.

3.3 Syllabus: For the Entrance test C.C.I.M., New Delhi approved syllabus of Ayurvedacharya (B.A.M.S.) will be applicable. The Entrance Test shall be of the standard of B. A. M. S. Examination and shall cover all the subjects of the B.A.M.S. course. The subject wise distribution of MCQs will be as follows.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 The candidate must be an Indian National. Nationality certificate issued by the District Magistrate or Additional District Magistrate or Chief Metropolitan Magistrate / valid passport Shall constitute proof of nationality.

4.2 The candidate must have passed B.A.M.S. Examination from a CCIM /AYUSH recognized Ayurved college and should have obtained registration either from the Central Council of Indian Medicine, New Delhi / Maharashtra Council of Indian Medicine or Any recognized state council/board after completion of one year rotating Internship training.

4.3 The candidate undergoing one year rotating internship training and likely to obtain final registration certificate from the Central Council of Indian Medicine New Delhi or Maharashtra Council of Indian Medicine or any of recognized state council / Board on or **before 25.10.2013** can also appear for the Entrance Test.

Such candidates will be required to submit a certificate from the Principal / Dean of the College regarding the likely date of completion of their rotating internship training failing which their application will be treated as incomplete and shall be rejected.

5. RAGGING

It must be noted that the institute considers ragging a recognizable offence and will not hesitate to take strong action against the offenders. Here are the extracts from the UGC's Committee Report.

Guidelines given by the University Grants

Commission to Curb the Menace of Ragging in Universities / Educational Institutions.

The word 'ragging' means the act of teasing, taunting, playing a practical joke upon someone or holding comic parades and other activities during certain period of a college term to raise money for charity.

Forms of ragging:

Ragging is found to take the following forms (the list is only indicative and not exhaustive)

Crisp Orders

- To address seniors as 'Sir'
- To perform mass drills
- To copy class notes for the seniors
- To serve various errands
- To do menial jobs for the seniors
- To ask/answer vulgar questions
- To look at pornographic pictures to 'shock the fresher's out of their innocence
- To force to drink alcohol, scalding tea, etc.
- To force to do acts with sexual overtones including homosexual acts
- To force to do acts this can lead to physical injury/mental torture or death
- To strip, kiss, etc.
- To do other obscenities

PUNISHMENTS

The following could be the possible punishments for those who are found guilty of participation in or abetment of ragging. The quantum of punishment shall naturally, depend upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Disciplinary Committee or the court of law.

1. Cancellation of admission
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/Examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, Youth festival, etc.
7. Expulsion from hostel
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to -1 semester.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent.
10. Fine up to Rs.25,000/-
11. Rigorous imprisonment up to three years.

While the first 10 types of punishment can be awarded by the appropriate authority of the institution itself, the last punishment can be awarded only by a court of law.

6. CENTER FOR ENTRANCE TEST

The Entrance Test will be conducted at **Dr.D.Y.Patil College of Ayurved & Research Institute, Sector 7, Nerul, Navi Mumbai on 10/10/2013, from 11.30 am to 2.30 pm.** Hall tickets numbers shall be displayed on notice board, 3rd floor at Dr. D.Y.Patil College of Ayurved, Sector-7, Nerul, Navi Mumbai on **07/10/2013. on or before 5 pm.**

7. APPLICATION FORM

7.1 A Candidate desirous of appearing for All India Post Graduate Ayurved Entrance Test of this University will be required to submit application in the prescribed form along with attested copies of the documents in support of Application. The application can be downloaded from website www.dypayurved.co.in or can be collect from the College office.

7.2 Entrance Test Fee

The Entrance Test Fee is Rs 3000/-. The fee is payable by demand draft drawn in favor of “Padmshree Dr. D. Y. Patil University”, C.B.D. Belapur, Navi Mumbai. Drawn on a nationalized / schedule bank, payable at Navi Mumbai or by cash. The Candidate should write his / her name, address & Phone no. on the reverse side of the demand draft.

7.3 The last date of receipt of completed Application form along with requisite documents and entrance test fee at the 3rd floor, office of Dr. D.Y. Patil College Ayurved & Research Institute building, Sector -7, Nerul, Navi Mumbai up to **5 pm on 23rd September 2013.** (with late fee of Rs. 500 up to **30th September 2013 till 5 pm**)

It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that his / her application reaches the office of the Ayurved College within the Specified time and date. The application received after the due date or not accompanied by entrance test fee/ supporting documents, shall be rejected and such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the entrance test. The university will not be responsible for non-receipts of applications within the specified time and date due to postal or courier service or any other cause for delays.

8. HALL TICKET

Hall Tickets carrying photograph of the candidates shall be issued to the candidates who are eligible to appear for the Entrance Test, for this purpose the candidate must submit two copies of recent passport size photograph (not more than three months old) along with the application form. They should write their name on the reverse side of the Photograph. **The Hall Tickets will not be Dispatched to the candidates. The candidates will have to Collect Hall Tickets from the Office, 3rd floor of the Dr.D.Y.Patil College of Ayurved & Research Institute, Nerul, Sector - 7, Navi Mumbai on 07/10/2013. up to 5 pm.**

The Hall Ticket must be presented in the Examination Hall for verification of candidate's **identity** / when instructed by the invigilator to do so and also at the time of counseling. The Hall Ticket is not transferable.

9. SELECTION PROCEDURE

9.1 The selection of the candidates will be done on the basis of inter-se-merit of the candidates taking into consideration the preference given by the candidate and availability of seat in the branch/discipline of his choice when it is his turn for counseling.

9.2 Tie Breaker

In case of equal marks at [AIPGET – AYURVED 2013](#) inter se-merit of the candidates will be determined by applying following tiebreaker rule:-

- a) First Level:** A Candidate securing higher percentage of marks in the aggregate of marks at the First, Second and Third B.A.M.S Examinations taken together will be preferred. If the tie still persists then:
- b) Second Level:** A candidate securing higher Percentage of marks in the Third B.A.M.S. Examination will be preferred. If the tie still Persists, then.
- c) Third Level:** A Candidate securing higher Percentage of marks at the Second B.A.M.S. Examination will be preferred. If the tie still Persists then.
- d) Fourth Level:** An older candidate will be Preferred over a younger candidate.

10. FEE STRUCTURE

10.1 Tuition Fee

For Non Clinical Subjects: (Samhita, Rachana, Kriya, Rasa sashtra)

- General Seats: Rs. 3,00,000/- Per Annum (Three Lakh only)
- Management Seats: Rs. 3,50,000/- Per Annum (Three Lakh fifty Thousand only)

For Clinical Subjects: (Rog Nidan, Swasthvritta, Shalya)

- General Seats: Rs. 4,00,000/- Per Annum (Four Lakh only)
- Management Seats: Rs. 4,50,000/- Per Annum (Four Lakh fifty Thousand only)

10.2 The tuition fee for the first year will have to be paid in form of D.D. in favour of Dr.

D.Y.Patil College of Ayurved & Research Institute, Nerul, Navi mumbai at the time of counseling i.e. **25/10/2013**, 11.00 am onwards. Otherwise admission will be automatically treated as cancelled.

10.3 The tuition fee for the subsequent years will have to be paid as and when notified by the University / College. The candidate may be required to give a bank guarantee to cover fees of the subsequent years.

10.4 The fees once paid are **non refundable**.

11. DECLARATION OF RESULT

The result of All India post graduate Ayurved Entrance Test 2013 will be declared on **21st October 2013** at **5.00 pm**. It will be displayed on the notice board at 3rd floor, DR. D. Y. Patil College Ayurved & Research Institute building, Sector -7, Nerul, Navi Mumbai.

Note:- Admission/s for the PG courses will be subject to permission of Dept. AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India for the year 2013-14.

12. COUNSELLING

12.1 The Counseling of eligible candidates will be on **25th October 2013**, 11 am onwards at 3rd floor, Dr. D.Y. Patil College Ayurved & Research Institute building, Sector -7, Nerul, Navi Mumbai.

12.2 At the time of counseling the eligibility of the candidates for admission shall be verified from original documents and those found eligible will be offered admission to a course.

12.3 The candidate will have to appear for Counseling at their own cost.

12.4 The Physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is essential. Absence of the candidate at the specified time, date and venue will result in instantaneous forfeiture of any claim for admission and the University will not be responsible for it.

12.5 Asking a candidate to report for counseling does not mean that he/she will be admitted to the course. The actual admission will depend upon the course and seat availability when his/ her turn comes in order of his / her inter-se-merit position.

Note:- Admission/s for the PG courses will be subject to permission of Dept. AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India for the year 2013-14.

- Passing certificates of I, II & III BAMS
- Rotating Internship Training Completion Certificate
- Certificate from the Principal/Dean of the College Indicating likely date of completion of Rotating Internship Training.
- Registration Certificate issued by MCIM / CCIM / any recognized State Council /Board.
- Bonafide Certificate issued from the Dean / Principal the College.

14. GUIDE LINES FOR ENTRANCE TEST

14.1 Candidate must be present at the Examination Hall and occupy the seat allotted to him half an hour before commencement of the Entrance test.

14.2 15 minutes prior to commencement of examination the invigilator will give general Instructions on taking the test.

14.3 During the test, the invigilator will check identity of the candidates by referring to the Hall Ticket given to him/her.

14.4 The candidate must sign the attendance sheet in the presence of the invigilator. The invigilator will also put his/her signature in the place provided in the Hall Ticket and Attendance Sheet.

14.5 The Answer-sheet will be given to the candidate at 11.15 am and Test-Booklet will be given at 11.25 am. The candidate shall carefully read instructions printed on both Test Booklet and Answer Sheet and make correct entries. The correctness of the entries will be cross checked by the invigilator. After 11.30am candidate will not allowed in examination Hall.

- 14.6** For answering the question, the candidate shall darken the appropriate circle using a Blue, Black Ball Point pen or Hb Pencil.
- 14.7** Each correct answer will be awarded one mark. However if more than one circles are darkened or any other marking method is used no marks will be awarded.
- 14.8** Rough work, if any should be done in the space provided in the Test Booklet. Rough work should not be done anywhere on the Answer-sheet.
- 14.9 Calculators**, Cellular Phones and any other electronic gadgets are not allowed in the Examination Hall.
- 14.10 Smoking** is strictly prohibited in the University Campus and Examination Hall.
- 14.11** No candidates will be allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the Entrance test time is over.
- 14.12** After the Entrance Test is over the candidate must hand over the Test Booklet and Answer- sheet to the invigilator.

15. DISCIPLINE

The candidates admitted for the courses in the constituent college of the University are subject to the discipline and conduct Rules of the University. The Disciplinary Committee of the University will deal with all cases involving discipline or conduct either suo moto or when referred to it by the Principal/Dean of the College. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in this regard.

16. COURT JURISDICTION

Any legal dispute arising out of conduct of All- India Post Graduate Ayurved Entrance Test 2013 (**AIPGET – AYURVED 2013**) and the admission procedure shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of Navi Mumbai and High Court of Mumbai Only.
