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ALL INDIA POLICE COMMANDO COMPETITION -2013
(23rd December 2013 - 28th December 2013 at Chennai)

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. INTRODUCTION

The 4th All India Police Commando Competition-2013 will be conducted at Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Oonamancherry, Chennai from 23rd December to 28th December 2013. States / UT Police Forces / CPOs may field one Commando Team in the competition.

2. AIM

The aim of this competition is to enhance physical and mental robustness, shooting skills, leadership qualities under stressful conditions and foster team spirit among the participants.

3. COMPOSITION OF THE TEAM

a. States / UT Police Forces / CPOs will field one Commando team as under :-

i) OIC : 01

ii) Others : 21

Total : 22

- b. Team is permitted to bring two reserves.
- c. Team must have 22 Nos. of Participants irrespective of ranks, however team leader should be minimum of the rank of Sub-Inspector.
- d. An individual will be permitted to participate in the competition three times only in three such competitions.
- e. There is no age limit for the participants.
- f. All participants of the teams must be medically fit. Each team will carry Medical fitness certificates, issued by their Medical Officer / Doctor after 1st October 2013.

- g. Each team will submit "Entry form" duly signed by Officer not below the rank of IGP fifteen days prior to the commencement of the competition. Proforma is attached at Appendix-A. "The Entry Form" signed by the officer below the rank of IGP will not be accepted.
- h. The entry form should have a certificate that all the participant are physically and mentally fit to participate in All India Police Commando competition and during the competition if any participant sustains any injury/ grievous hurt, organizers will not be responsible (Proforma enclosed)
- i. A random Dope Test will be conducted during the competition to prevent individuals for taking performance enhancing substances / drugs.

5. DURATION

It will be a six days event including opening & closing, participating teams will be put through the competition in four stages.

6. SCHEDULE OF TEAMS

Draw of lots will be conducted one day prior to the commencement of the competition for the sequence and time of competition of teams. Draw will be conducted in the presence of all team Managers / Coaches and representatives of the All India Police Sports Control board during the Managers' Meeting.

7. WEAPONS & AMMUNITION

a. It has been decided that there should be no embargo on weapon profile of any team. Any weapon capable for simulation of actual fire and whose blank ammunition is available will be carried by Commandos for the competition. (Hand guns/ Revolvers will not be permitted.) Weapon with open sight metallic foresight – Back sight shall be permitted during competition and no weapon fitted with telescope or dot sight would be allowed to be used. Team will use only one type of weapon for the competition. Weapon will not be changed during the competition. Teams will bring their own armourer and will provide weapon fitness certificate at Marshalling Point.

- b. Arms & Ammunition for firing at Reflex Shooting Range and blank ammunition for simulation of small team operation will be brought by the respective teams.

8. CONDUCT

The competition will be conducted in four stages which are as under:

- Stage I : Briefing
- Stage II : Confidence Course (19 obstacles)
- Stage III : Firing
- Stage IV : Small team operation

The sequence of conduct of above mentioned stages will be as under:

- a) Narrative will be issued to all teams on E-1 day at 0800 hrs and all teams will deposit solutions including Sketch / blow up/ enlargement by 1600 hrs on the same day. E is the day of allotment based on lots for respective teams. Briefing will be done as per plan submitted in the solution. No deviation or change will be allowed after submitting the solution.
- b) Teams will not be allowed to seek any type of external assistance from Team Managers or others while preparing the sketch, plan and briefing for the Small Team Operations.
- c) Teams will report at the Marshalling area one hour prior to the time of competition of team.
- d) Marshalling will be carried out at the Marshalling Area.
- e) After marshalling, the team will move for the briefing point (Start Point of the competition) where the team leader will brief his team. The Sketch / Blow up/ Enlargement submitted by team leader will be handed over to him before briefing.
- f) The moment team leader starts his briefing, the time of competition for the team will start.

- g) After briefing, the team will move to the first obstacle of the Confidence Course. Distance between the Start Point and Confidence Course which is approx. 1.3 Kms should be covered by the complete team in 9.30 minutes. In the event of delay team will be penalized five marks for delay of every 30 seconds or part thereof.
- h) When the team completes the Confidence Courses, it will reach Reflex Shooting Range. The Reflex Shooting Range which is approximately 2.4 K.M. should be covered by the complete team in 15 minutes. In the event of delay team will be penalized five marks for delay of every one minute or part thereof.
- i) When the complete team reaches the ReflexShootingRange, firing will start.
- j) Once the last person of the team finishes firing, the team will move for the Small Team Operation.
Tactical operation will commence after firing and team will be tested for Ambush and Counter Ambush drills en-route.
- k) Time for the entire operation will be counted till the Team Leader gives report of the successful completion of the operation.
- l) No allowances for injury to any participant during the competition will be given.
- m) No replacement of any injured participant of the team during the conduct of competition will be permitted.
- n) All the stages of the competition should be finished by a team within 4 hours 45 minutes. For every delay of five minutes or part thereof, there will be a penalty of two marks.

9. BRIEFING

Team leader will brief his team about his planning for the conduct of the small Team Operation. Considering the linguistic problems, Briefing could be done either in Hindi or English. If

any other option is taken, the States should inform hosting organization 15 days prior to the commencement of competition so that officers knowing that language could be incorporated in the panel of umpires / board. The general format of the briefing is as under: -

- i) Introduction to Enlargement
- ii) Landmarks
- iii) Situation
- iv) Mission
- v) Execution
- vi) Administration & Logistics
- vii) Command, Communication, & Co-Ordination
- viii) Synchronization.

10. CONFIDENCE COURSE

- i) The obstacle course will have 19 obstacles, spread over 1.3 Kms. The type of obstacles and their marks will be as under :-

- ii) At each obstacle, there will be an umpire (nominated by the organizers) to ensure that all members of a team negotiate the obstacle in a prescribed manner.
- iii) Each participant of a team will be released after a gap of one minute. The time for each participant will be noted down individually.
- iv) Participants will be required to negotiate the obstacles in succession.
- v) Participants may make any number of attempts on the obstacles subject to maintaining proper sequence of the obstacles. In no case they will be permitted to come back to a previous obstacle after having negotiated the next. The participants will not be given any benefit of time while doing so.
- vi) The participants will not be permitted to help each other in negotiation of the obstacles.
- vii) The demonstration of the correct method of negotiation of each obstacle of the Confidence Course may be given two days prior to the competition. The participants will be awarded marks

only if they negotiate each obstacle in the manner demonstrated by the Demo Team.

viii) In case of controversy matter will be referred to the Technical Committee.

ix) In case of any protest, a written protest along with prescribed fees of Rs 500/- will be submitted to the Organizing Secretary or Jury of Appeal within two hours. The decision taken by the competent authority will be final.

x) Scoring in terms of timings of the individual will be as under :-

Timings	Marks
a) 12 mts and below negotiating all obstacles	: 25
b) 12 mts 01 Sec – 13 mins 30 secs	: 20
c) 13 mts 31 secs – 15 mts	: 15
d) 15 mts 01 secs – 16 mts 30 secs	: 10
e) 16 mins 31 secs – 19 mts	: 05
f) Above 19 mts	: 00

xi) If a particular obstacle is not negotiated or wrongly attempted /negotiated by the individual, it will be considered as “Not Done and marks will be deducted as mentioned in Para 10(i)

xii) Maximum of 100 mks can be scored by a participant (i.e. 75 mks on successful negotiation of all the obstacles + 25 marks for negotiation of all obstacles within timings as mentioned above.

xiii) The marks of timings will be subject to the negotiation of all obstacles but if an individual does not negotiate any obstacle and comes within 19 minutes, he will be awarded 5 mks only for timing in Confidence Course.

xiv) If a participant misses or is not able to negotiate four or more than four obstacles, the marks secured by him will not be counted for calculation of team score.

- xv) Completion of the Confidence Course by a participant after a lapse of 19 mts will disqualify him and points secured by such participant will not be considered for calculation of the team score.
- xvi) Marks of the Confidence Course for a team will be the total marks scored by the team participants divided by the number of participants i.e. 22

11. FIRING

- i) Firing will be carried out in buddy pairs after reaching at the ReflexShootingRange
- ii) Each pair will be given 10 Rds in two magazines of 5 Rds each.
- iii) Magazine will be put on the Rifle on order and change lever at "S" position.
- iv) The firers will be in standing position.
- v) Two targets will be exposed at a time and a total number of 10 targets will be exposed to each pair.
- vi) On appearance of the target, the pair will engage target. Exposure of the target will be for three seconds and the gap between the two exposures will be two to five seconds.
- vii) Either member of the buddy pair may engage any target. However, the weapon or ammunition will not be changed.
- viii) No allowance for misfire, any defect in weapon or ammunition will be given to the participants.
- ix) Scoring will be done after firing of buddy pair, Scoring will be 01 mark per hit per target. Only one hit per target will be counted.
- x) Marks of firing for a team will be 110.
- xi) Targets will be spread over a distance of 20 to 50 mtrs.

12. SMALL TEAM OPERATION

- i) Once complete team finishes firing at the Reflex Shooting Range, it will move to conduct the Small Team Operation. It has been decided to include Urban Commando Operation i.e. House Clearing Drill along with Jungle/Rural Commando Operation. The team will be asked to conduct a "Raid on Terrorist Hideout" Only map and compass will be used for navigation in small team operation. Use of Global Positioning System (GPS) is not permitted. The team will be tested for Ambush and Counter Ambush drills en route. In conduct of the operation team will be assessed on various tactical concepts as under : -

- a) Tactical move during conduct
- b) Establishment of commando base (if any)
- c) Security of Commando base (if any)
- d) Troops to task.
- e) Deployment of parties.
- f) Action of cut off and support groups
- g) Sentry silencing technique.
- h) Formation during raid.
- i) Search of area
- j) Demolition of hide out.
- k) Command & Control of operation and sub group commander
- l) Maintenance of surprise.


13. MARKING PROCEDURE AT A GLANCE

- i) Marking procedure for the competition is as under :-
- a. Briefing : 20 Marks
 - b. Confidence course :100 Marks
 - c. Firing :110 Marks

- d. Small Teams Ops (Conduct)
 - i. Urban Commando Operation : 35 Marks
 - ii. Jungle/Rural Commando Operation : 35 Marks
- ii) The Umpire/ Officials, Jury and Technical Committee for the competition will be from CPOs and SPOs.

14. TROPHIES / MEDALS

- i) Separate winners Runner-Up & Hardliner trophies will be presented to the teams coming First, Second and Third Positions.
- ii) The trophies will be rolling trophies. Gold, Silver & Bronze medals will be presented to the teams declared First, Second & Third Positions in the SPOs/ CPOs.
- iii) In case of tie the team obtaining maximum marks in firing will be declared winner. If the mark are equal then the team having more marks in Confidence Course will be declared winner. If the mark of firing and confidence Course are equal then team having more marks in Briefing will be declared winner.
- iv) Entry fees for the competition will be Rs 50/- per participant including reserves.

4th ALL INDIA POLICE COMMANDO COMPETITION – 2013
JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

The Tamil Nadu Police is hosting the 4th All India Police Commando Competition for the year 2013. The All India Police Commando Competition will be conducted in accordance with rules prescribed by the Central Committee, All India Police Duty Meet, New Delhi.

2. DATE

The 4th All India Police Commando Competition -2013 will be held from 23rd December 2013 to 28th December 2013.

3. VENUE

All the events will be conducted at the Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Oonamancherry, near Vandalur, Chennai.

4. CLIMATE

Chennai weather is hot and humid as it lies close to the equator and is also on the coast. The temperature varies from 20 °C to 30 °C.

5. VENUE AND REPORTING DATE

All participating teams are required to report at the control room of 4th All India Police Commando Competition 2013 at TamilNaduPoliceAcademy, Oonamancherry, near Vandalur, Chennai , Contact No. 9840366100. It is advised that team should arrange their journey in such way that they arrive at Chennai Railway Station latest by the morning of 22st Dec 2013.

6. RECEPTION AND TRANSPORTATION

All the teams arriving by trains will be received at Chennai Central Railway Station and will be escorted to their places of accommodation. Reception center will be set at Chennai Railway Station. Participants arriving by air will be received at

ChennaiAirport. It is requested that mode and date of journey, train, flight number may please be communicated well in advance to the ADGP, Operations, Marutham, No.17, Boat Club Road, Raja AnnamalaiPuram, Chennai-28 Phone No. 09840366100, Fax No. 044-24343660 e-mail marutham28@gmail.com and necessarily should register themselves through phone/ e-mails . The transport arrangements for the participants to travel between the venue and accommodation will also be arranged. Each team will be provided with one liaison Officer.

7. ACCOMMODATION & MESSING

All participating teams and accompanying officials will be provided with suitable accommodation at TamilNadu PoliceAcademy, Chennai. Teams must carry their bedding and mosquito nets etc. All participating teams are requested to clearly intimate the number of participants in our email ID so that suitable lodging arrangements etc can be made accordingly. We will not be in a position to provide centralized messing facilities to all teams. However, necessary facilities for running messes will be provided to each team on payments basis. Each team is requested to bring their own messing arrangements including cooks, sweepers, helpers, followers, utensils etc. Dry ration and fresh vegetables will be supplied on demand to teams in advance payment basis. The accommodation arrangement committee will arrange to supply LPG gas cylinders to all the teams. Gas cylinders will be made available on a security deposit of Rs.3000/-. No fire wood will be allowed to be used for cooking purpose.

8. AIR/RAIL RESERVATIONS

Participating teams and officers must arrange their return air /rail reservation in advance. However, necessary assistance will be provided to all teams.

9. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Every competitor participating in the competition should have completed a minimum of one year of continuous service in police Forces and certificate to that effect should be appended at the bottom of the entry form duly signed by an officer not below the rank of IGP. The entry forms should not contain more names than the limits as laid down.

10. ENTRY FORM

The Entry Form signed by an officer not below the rank of Inspector General of Police is required to be sent to organizing Secretary before 15-11-2013. The entry forms should have a certificate stating that all the participants are physically and mentally fit to participate in All India Police Commando Competition and that during the competition, if any participant sustains any injury/grievous hurt, organizers will not be responsible. The Proforma of Entry Form is attached as appendix .

11. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees for the competition will be Rs.50/-per participant including reserves/Team Manager/Coaches and others. This fee has to be sent to the Organizing Secretary, 4th All India Police Commando Competition-2013 along with the Entry Forms. It is requested that this amount may be remitted through Bank Draft in favor of Organizing Secretary, 4th All India Police Commando Competition-2013, payable at State Bank of India, Chennai Main Branch.

12. CONDUCT

The competition will be conducted as per the instructions given in the General Instructions communicated by this office letter No.555-19/TNCF-TNCS/AIPCC/2013, Dated: 19/09/2013.

13. CLINIC MEETING

A clinic meeting of the Team Managers and Coaches with respective conducting Officers will be held at Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Oonamancherry, Chennai on 22nd Dec 2013 at 15:30 hrs. It is compulsory for all the participating Team Managers to attend the meeting. The Technical officials and the Organizing Secretary will also brief the teams.

14. DRAW OF LOTS

Draw of Lots will be conducted one day prior (22-12-2013) to the commencement of the Competition for the sequence and timing of competition of the teams. Draw will be conducted in the presence of all Teams Managers/Coaches during the Managers Meeting

15. UNIFORM

All the members of the participating teams are requested to wear prescribed Commando Uniform during the Competition and also during the Inaugural and Valedictory Ceremonies.

16. OPENING & CLOSING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will be held on 23rd Dec 2013 in the forenoon and closing ceremony will be held on 28th Dec 2013 afternoon at the Tamil Nadu Police Academy, Oonamancherry, Chennai.

All teams should bring their respective State Police / Central Police Organization/ Union territories Police flags of the following specifications.

- a. Flag for Hoisting : 6' x 4' - 2 Nos.
- b. Flag for March Past : 3' x 2' – 1 No.

17. DISCIPLINE AND SECURITY

- a. A high standard of discipline is expected from all ranks in the participating teams. The Team Manager / Captain will be personally responsible for the discipline of the team during the

competition. All participants are required to bring their Identity Cards and Health Card/ Medical Fitness Certificate. No participant will be allowed to participate in the competition without identity card and health card/Medical fitness certificate.

- b. The Team Managers of the participating teams should deposit two recent passport size photographs in uniform of each participant/ official for the purpose of preparing Commando Competition Identity Cards at arrival in TamilNadu Police Academy, Chennai.

18.MEDICAL

There is a Government hospital at Tambaram. Medical back up during conduct of competition will be provided by the Hospital.

Each participating team is requested to designate a senior officer as the liaison officer and his Name, Rank, Address including Phone/Fax No; and e-mail address may kindly be intimated.

- c) The organizing committee will not entertain any dispute. The decision of the Jury of Appeal will be final in this regard.

24. ENTERTAINMENT / CULTURAL PROGRAMS:


Arrangement for variety and cultural program has been made. Participating teams are requested to come prepared with presentation of some items of dance, group/solo song, skit etc.
