Outstanding teachers with 15 years of UG teaching/research experience or an outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge may also be considered.

DQ: Specialisation in International Law, Public Law and Commercial Law.

Librarian : EQ: (1): A Master's Degree in Library Sciences from a recognised University or its equivalent..(2) At least thirteen years as a Deputy Librarian in a University Library or eighteen years experience as a College Librarian..(3) The candidate must be between 35 to 55 years of age as on 15/11/2013.
