

#### I. General Instructions:

1. Candidates seeking admission to D.M./M.Ch. super speciality / higher speciality courses should submit the application form with necessary enclosures which should reach

- 2. The candidates shall ensure that the completed application form with all particulars and enclosures reaches the university within the date and time specified. Applications received by speed post / courier or any other means, after the last date and time will not be accepted irrespective of the date of booking.
- 3. The university shall not be responsible for any delay in the receipt or for the loss in transit of application form.
- 4. Request for extension of time for submission of documents called for, after the specified date and time will not be entertained.

#### II. Eligibility for Admission:

1. Candidates should possess Post Graduate M.D. / M.S. or its equivalent recognized Degree for D.M./M.Ch. courses respectively as prescribed by the Medical Council of India.

- 2. Candidates should have obtained permanent registration either from the Medical Council of India or any of the State Medical Councils.

  Candidates should produce the additional qualification registration certificate of their post graduate degree from the Medical Council of India or the respective State Medical Council.
- 3. All other conditions as laid by the Medical Council of India will apply.

#### III. Duration of the Course:

The period of training for obtaining D.M./M.Ch. Degrees shall be 3 completed years.

#### IV. Submission of Application:

- 1. Application form can be obtained from the office of the Registrar, Chettinad Academy of Research & Education on payment of ₹2,500/- (Rupees Two thousand five hundred only)
- 2. The application form can also be downloaded from the University's official website www.chettinadhealthcity.com. The downloaded application duly filled in shall be submitted along with a Demand Draft for the amount drawn in favour of "Chettinad Academy of Research and Education" payable at Chennai. The name of the candidate and the higher speciality applied for i.e. D.M. or M.Ch. should be mentioned on the reverse of the demand draft.
- 3. Application form should be filled in carefully and legibly by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
- 4. Furnishing of false information or suppression of material / information in the form will make the application treated as cancelled.

#### V. Certificates to be enclosed along with the application:

Photocopies of the following certificates duly attested by a Government Gazetted officer, should be enclosed along with the application form

- 1. Proof for Date of Birth and Age
- 2. The Post Graduate Course Completion Certificate from the parent college institution where the candidate had undergone the Post Graduate Degree Course
- 3. M.B.B.S. Degree Certificate
- 4. Post Graduate Degree Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate awarded by the university concerned to which the institution is affiliated.
- 5. Permanent Medical Registration Certificate of the M.B.B.S. Degree and additional qualification Registration Certificate for Post Graduate Degree issued by the Medical Council of India or any State Medical Council.
- 6. Post Graduate Degree Attempt Certificate obtained from the institution where the candidate completed his/her Post Graduate Degree.
- 7. Conduct Certificate issued by the head of the institution last studied.
- 8. Migration Certificate wherever applicable.
- 9. Community Certificate ...... for the purpose of statistics only.

#### VI. Photograph:

Two identical and recently taken passport size colour photographs are required. Candidates should affix the photograph in the space provided in the application form.

#### VII. Scheme of Entrance Examination:

- 1. All the candidates seeking admission should appear for the All India Level Common Entrance Examination conducted by Chettinad Academy of Research & Education.
- 2. The Entrance Examination question paper will consists of 180 multiple choice questions covering all the subjects of M.B.B.S. Degree Course and specalities concerned (broad and higher).
- 3. The duration of the entrance examination will be 3 hours.
- 4. Candidates should report at the examination centre 30 minutes before the commencement of examination. No candidates will be allowed to enter examination hall 30 minutes after commencement of examination.
- 5. Candidates will not be allowed to carry textual material, printed or written, bits of paper or any prohibited materials such as mobile phones, calculator, paging device or electronic gadget inside the examination hall. If anyone happens to bring any of these items the same should be deposited outside the examination hall solely at the risk of the candidates.
- 6. Candidates should maintain silence in the examination hall.

The candidates should reach the examination centre at their own expenses.

IX. Date & Time of Entrance Examination: 28.06.2014 (Saturday) - 10.30 am to 1.30 pm

#### X. Hall Ticket:

- 1. Hall Ticket for the Entrance Examination will be issued only to the eligible candidates. If any candidate has not received the Hall Ticket he/she should contact the office of the Registrar over phone immediately or report by fax. For such candidates, duplicate Hall Ticket will be issued on the day of the examination at the examination centre.
- 2. Admission to the Entrance Examination will not guarantee admission to the course.
- 3. Hall Ticket must be produced at the time of Entrance Examination without fail.
- 4. No candidates will be allowed to write the Entrance Examination without a valid Hall Ticket.

#### XI. Mode of Selection:

- 1. Selection will be made based on the marks secured by the candidate in the All India Level Common Entrance Examination.
- 2. Merit list will be displayed in the University Notice Board.
- 3. The university will not intimate the unsuccessful candidates individually regarding the result of Entrance Examination and no correspondence on this subject will be entertained.

#### XII. Counseling:

Counseling dates will be intimated individually to the candidates.

#### XIII. Commencement of the Course:

The classes will commence on 01.08.2014.

#### XIV. Important Dates:

1. Last date for receipt of completed application form : 25.06.2014 (Wednesday) before 4.30 pm

2. Date & Time of Entrance Examination : 28.06.2014 (Saturday) - 10.30 am to 1.30 pm

3. Commencement of Classes : 01.08.2014 (Friday)

#### XV. Others:

- 1. "A postgraduate student of a postgraduate degree course in broad specialities/super specialities would be required to present one poster presentation, to read one paper at a national/state conference and to present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his postgraduate studies so as to make him eligible to appear at the postgraduate degree examination." as prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations notified vide Gazette Notification dated 09/12/2009 (Clause 13.9).
- 2. As per Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations under Clause 14.(4)(a) it has been prescribed that "Every candidate shall carry out work on an assigned research project under the guidance of a recognized Post Graduate Teacher, the result of which shall be written up and submitted in the form of a Thesis. The thesis shall be examined by a minimum of three examiners; one internal and two external examiners, who shall not be the examiners for Theory and Clinical examination. A candidate shall be allowed to appear for the Theory and Practical/Clinical examination only after the acceptance of the Thesis by the examiners."
