## **POST GRADUATE COMMON ENTRANCE TEST – 2014**

#### for admission to 1st Year / 1st Semester M.E. / M. Tech. / M. Arch Courses

Pursuant to the Government Order No. ED 36 TEC 2014 dated 23-05-2014, applications are invited from the eligible interested Karnataka and non-Karnataka candidates for admission to 1st year / 1st semester full time / part time M.E. / M. Tech. / M. Arch courses in the institutions affiliated Universities which will be notified by the Government of Karnataka for the year 2014-15. Candidates have to appear for the Post Graduate Common Entrance Test -2014 conducted by the Karnataka Examinations Authority to become eligible for admission to these courses as per the provisions of the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Master of Engineering (ME) and Master of Technology (M.Tech) courses, Rules, 2005.

#### **NOTE to GATE Candidates:**

The candidates with valid GATE score should compulsorily enter application online to become eligible for admission to M.E. / M. Tech / M. Arch courses, but they need not appear for PGCET-2014.

**Academic Eligibility:** The details of academic eligibility for all the above courses are available on the KEA website http://kea.kar.nic.in. The candidates are advised to verify the eligibility criteria before applying to any of the courses.

# How to Apply?:

- Step1: Enter all the details ONLINE by browsing URL on web http://kea.kar.nic.in by selecting "PGET-2014". After completion of entry of all the details candidate's will receive an application ID and Password to their registered email address and also the same information will be displayed on the screen.
- **Step 2:** Upload the scanned copy of recent passport size Colour Photo and Signature in JPG format separately.
- Step 3: Take the printout of the Challan copy which is in Duplicate/Triplicate. Candidates have to pay an amount of Rs. 650/- for General and OBC (Rs.500/- for SC / ST Category 1 only for Karnataka candidates). The candidates have to pay the requisite fee in any of the branch of State Bank of Mysore. Further, candidates residing in Karnataka can also pay in E-payment Post offices. The Post Office will retain Post Office copy of the Challan and handover the Candidate cope of the Challan to the candidates.
- Step 4:Take a printout of the application form on A-4 Size paper. Affix candidate's recent Passport size Photo, signature, Left Hand Thumb Impression on the space provided. Afterwards obtain Principal seal and signature from the college where you have studied final BE / B.Tech or QE on the space provided in the printed form. The same copy should be produced during document verification along with the copy of the Challan.
- Note: Candidates should note down their application ID and Password until the completion of filling of the online application. Candidate has to enter all the required details in the form, failing which their application will not be considered. Applications without Photo and signature will not be considered as valid. Candidates are not allowed to edit their application after taking the printout.
