Online Applications are invited from qualified and eligible candidates for recruitment of 85 Assistant Lineman in the time scale of Rs.7,950 – 150 – 8,100 – 190 – 9,050 – 240 – 10,250 – 300 – 11,750 - 360 – 16,790, in Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Limited.

- > Applications are invited from "Female Candidates" possessing pass certificate of 18/24 months course as on 11.01.2012 in "Electrician/Electronics/Electronic Mechanic" trade from Industrial Training Institutes (ITI) recognized by the Government of Karnataka.
- > Applications are invited from the "Male/Female candidates" who have passed 10th STD and Three years pass certificate of "Lineman/Electrician trade" (ITC) imparted from the Industrial Training Institute of KEB/KPTCL.

Note: The male applicants who had earlier applied to the post of Assistant Lineman in Notification dated: 12.12.2011 need not apply once again their applications submitted earlier will be considered.

1) Composition of posts:

Note: Candidates selected as Assistant Lineman will be posted anywhere within the jurisdiction of the KPTCL and posting to the vacant posts will be done through counseling based on the merit.

2) Requisite Qualification:

a) For ITI candidates:

Should have a pass certificate of 18/24 months course in "Electrician/Electronics/Electronic Mechanic" trade from Industrial Training Institutes (ITI) recognized by Government of Karnataka.

b) For ITC candidates:

Should have passed 10th STD Examination and pass certificate of THREE YEARS "Lineman trade/Electrician trade" (ITC) imparted by the Industrial Training Institutes of KEB/KPTCL.

Note: Candidates possessing qualification in other disciplines/ branches other than what is specified above need not apply.

Other Qualifications:

- i) Should have knowledge of Kannada to read and write.
- ii) Should have normal eye sight.
- iii) Should have satisfactory physical fitness and shall qualify in the Endurance Test.

3) Eligibility:

The candidates who have obtained minimum percentage of marks as prescribed below in respective qualifying examinations only are eligible to apply for the posts.

4) Selection:

- i) Recruitment to the posts of ALM will be made by selection **strictly on merit**, based on the marks secured in the Qualifying Examination only, duly following the reservation policies of the Government of Karnataka. Candidates will be called for Endurance Test in the ratio of 1:5.
- ii) Endurance test will be conducted in the following events;

a) 100 meters Running - 14 seconds

b) Skipping - 50 times in one minute

c) Shot put 12 pounds - 8 meters throw (3 opportunities)
d) Climbing of Electric Pole - 8 meters height (Compulsory)

e) 800 meters Running - 3 minutes

No marks are allocated to the endurance test. However, in order to qualify for the selection, the candidate has to <u>compulsorily climb the Electric Pole(event No. d)</u> and get through in 2 other events out of the remaining 4 events (i.e. event No. a, b, c & e).

iii) Medical Examination will be conducted from a Competent Medical Officer during the Endurance Test and the candidate should have satisfactory physical fitness.

iv) All the original documents will be verified on the day of the Endurance Test which

will be conducted at Bangalore

v) Date and location of the endurance test will be notified to the shortlisted candidates through the website. Only those candidates who have furnished there mobile No. in the application forms will be intimated through SMS.

5) Age:

The candidates should have attained the age of 18 years as on the last date fixed for receipt of application and shall not be more than;

- 35 years in case of General Merit candidates.
- 38 years in case of Category IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB candidates. ii)
- 40 years in case of SC/ST and Category I candidates.

Note:

- a) The candidates who are trained for a period of three years as "Lineman/ Electrician" trade in KEB/ KPTCL Training Institutes, relaxation in the upper age limit extended up to the period of training subject to a maximum of three years.
- b) Age relaxation from 9/12/2011 till of issue of Notification, will be extended to the female candidates possessing ITI Certificates as per the Orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka.
- c) Age relaxation from 9/12/2011 till of issue of Notification, will be extended to the female candidates possessing ITC Certificates as per the Orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka.
- d) For Ex-Military Personnel (Ex-MP) the upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years plus the No. of years of service rendered by them in the Armed Forces of the Union of India not exceeding 45 years of age as on the last date prescribed for receiving the application.
- e) In case of in-service employees, the upper age limit is relaxable by the No. of years of continuous service rendered by them, subject to a maximum of 7 years.
- f) The candidates who have worked or working on contract basis in KPTCL/ ESCOMs as Gangmen/ Bill boys/ Probationary Mazdoors/ Temporary Cleaners/ Sanitary worker and Temporary Meter Readers the upper age limit is relaxable by number of years of service rendered by them subject to a maximum of 10 years. The Candidate claiming age relaxation on the above basis has to produce a certificate from the concerned KPTCL/ ESCOMs authority.
- g) As per the Order dated:26.11.2013 of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in writ Appeal No:3074. 3083 of 2012, the age limit is relaxable from 12.12.2011 upto the date of this Notification to three years ITC candidates who were eligible as on 12.12.2011.
- h) GOK in its Order No:EN 193 EEB 2012 dated 19.01.2013 has granted exemption from extending 30% reservation quota earmarked for women category in direct recruitment of Assistant Lineman.

Application Fee:

1) Rs. 400/- (Rupees Four Hundred only) in respect of candidates belonging to General Candidate and Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB.

2) Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) in respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST Category.

3) Candidates can pay the Application fee by using Net Banking option, any Bank ATM cum Debit card, Internet Banking.

Candidates can also pay the Application fee using Off Line i.e., pay by Challan at State Bank of India Branches.

4) Application fees shall be paid during hours between 10.00 A.M and 4.00 PM only.

7) Submission of Application:

- a) Applications should be submitted strictly "ONLINE" by logging on to www.kptcl.com, Applications will not be accepted by any other mode.
- b) The application shall be submitted through **online** from **01.07.2014 to 31.07.2014** upto 17.30Hrs.
- c) After applying, the candidates should take the printout of the Bank Challan generated online and pay the requisite application fee along with applicable bank charges in any of the branches of STATE BANK OF INIDA. In case, the candidates fail to pay the fees after submitting the application, their applications will not be considered. Special Note:
 - Candidate who pays the requisite application fee, by obtaining the 'Bank Challan', during the Banking hours, after submitting the application through 'On-Line'; only such applications will be considered for recruitment.
 - If the application fee is paid before or after the NOTIFIED DATE, then such candidate's application will not be considered and the amount paid will neither be adjusted nor refunded under any circumstances.
- d) After submitting the application ONLINE the candidates should obtain the printouts of acknowledgement and Bank Challan and the same should be produced at the time of **ENDURANCE TEST**.
- e) Candidates should submit the application well in advance without waiting for the last date prescribed for submission. Fees paid once shall not be refunded under any circumstances or adjusted towards any future recruitments.

8) General Instructions:

- a) Only Indian citizens are eligible to apply.
- b) No person who has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or who has been temporarily debarred or disqualified by the Union or any State Public Service Commission from appearing for examination or selections conducted by it shall be appointed unless the Company after review of all the circumstances considers him suitable for such appointment.
- c) Candidates who obtain appointment by furnishing false information in the application are liable to be terminated.
- d) Postal address furnished in the application is final and no correspondence for change of address at a later date will be entertained.
- e) Candidates who have appeared for the qualifying examination but whose results are not declared before the last date fixed for receiving applications, need not apply.
- f) Before filling up the online application forms, the eligible candidates shall go through instructions made available in the website.
- g) Candidates are expected to know the criteria for claiming reservation under SC, ST Categories I, IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB as well as norms for horizontal reservation under each quota prevailing in Government of Karnataka as on the last date prescribed for submission of application.
- h) The decision of KPTCL in matters relating to eligibility of candidates will be final and binding.
- i) Canvassing in any form for appointment will be a disqualification.
- j) Original documents/ Testimonials/ Certificates/ Records etc., shall be produced for verification with attested copy, only when called for.
- k) GOK vide Order No.EN/115/EEB/2010 (part-II) dated:25.01.2012 has granted exemption from providing reservation to persons with disabilities as per section 32 of The Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities Protection of Rights and Full Participation)Act, 1995.
- Selected candidates will have to give an undertaking on a stamped paper of Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred Only) stating that he will serve the Company continuously for a minimum period of one year from the date of reporting.
- m) The KPTCL reserves the right to cancel the Employment Notification during any stage without prejudice to issue fresh notification, if necessary.
- n) No correspondence or enquiries will be entertained form candidates about the recruitment status. All relevant information at various stages of recruitment will be made available in the KPTCL web site.
- o) Candidates applied under category and selected, their appointment orders will be issued only after receipt of validity certificate from the concerned authorities, irrespective of their selection under GM/Category Quota.
