IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1.	BSF will hold an All India Examination for recruitment to the different post of Group 'B' & 'C' of Water Wing in BSF for the year-2014.
2.	Candidates are advised to go through the requirement of educational qualification, age, physical standards, physical efficiency test etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the posts, before applying. BSF reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any stage of the selection process, if he is found not qualifying any of the prescribed eligibility criteria. The detailed advertisement is available on the BSF website www.bsf.nic.in
3.	Candidates seeking reservation benefits for Govt. Servant/OBC/SC/ST/Ex-Servicemen must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed in the notice. They should also be in possession of the certificates in the format prescribed by Government of India in support of their claim at the time of application.
4.	Central Government Employees/Servants claiming age relaxation should be in possession of a certificate in the prescribed format from their office, in respect of the length of continuous service which should be for not less than three years in the immediate period preceding the closing date for receipt of application. They should continue to have the status of Central Government Civilian Servants/Employees from the day of application till the time of appointment on the basis of their performance in this examination to be eligible for such age relaxation.
5.	Each application should be accompanied by a Demand Draft/Postal Order for Rs. 50/- (Fifty) as examination fee in favour of the addressee to whom the application is addressed, payable at respective SBI/Post Office at the location or nearby station. However, fee is exempted for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, BSF Candidates, Ex-Servicemen..
6.	Closing Date: Application duly filled up in the given format may be sent within 30 days from the date of publication of the Notice in Employment News . The last date of receipt of application in respect of candidates belonging to areas of North Eastern State, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu & Kashmir State, Lahaul & Spiti Districts and Pangi Sub Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands or the Union territory of Lakshadweep is within 45 days from the date of publication of advertisement in Employment News.
7.	Mobiles and other Electronic Gadgets are banned within the premises of the Examination Centers.
8.	The selected candidate are liable to be posted anywhere in the Country as per the transfer policy of the Force.
9.	The recruitment will be done on All India Basis.

10.	Selected candidate will be governed by BSF Act and Rules.
11.	On appointment they shall be entitled for pension benefits as per the “ New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme ” applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government services w.e.f 01 st Jan' 2004.
12.	The application form and Admit Card (Annexure-‘A’ & ‘B’) must be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting/typewritten. Correction, if any, should be legible and attested by the candidate.
13.	Applications, which are not on prescribed format or not accompanied by the required enclosures or incomplete or defective shall be summarily rejected. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained under any circumstances.
14.	The envelope containing the application must be superscripted in bold letters as “ “APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF SI(Workshop)/SI(MASTER)/SI(ENGINE DRIVER)/HC(MASTER)/HC(ENGINE DRIVER)/ HC(WORKSHOP)/ CT(CREW) IN BSF WATER WING- 2014”. ”.
15.	Candidate serving in Government/Semi Government/Public Sector undertakings should apply through proper channel. No objection certificate from their employer will be required to be submitted at the time of personal interview
16.	Candidates are not required to submit any original certificates in support to their claims. They should ensure they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the tests and interview. If on verification at a later stage it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature will be cancelled by the Selection Board.
17.	All eligible candidates who apply in response to this advertisement before the closing date will be assigned Registration/Roll Numbers. They will be communicated through Call letters/Admit Cards for appearing in the First Phase of the selection process i.e Written Examination.
18.	Candidates are informed that the Written Examination will be followed by Documentation, Physical Standard Test, Physical Efficiency Test, Interview & Medical Examination. Final merit list as per the advertised vacancies will be prepared in respect of candidates who have qualified all the stages/events.
19.	The recruitment board shall not be liable for any claim arising out of any injury etc. suffered during the tests. The decision of the recruitment board shall be final in all matters connected with this recruitment.
20.	The appointment will be subject to the conditions that the candidates are medically as well as physically fit. The selected candidates will have to undergo Basic Training at any of the Training Institutions of BSF. The services of those candidates who fail to complete the training successfully are liable to be terminated.
21.	An employee serving in the same rank and pay grade will not be entitled to apply for said post.
22.	Candidates belonging to the Physically Handicapped category are <u>not eligible</u> to apply for this examination.
23.	Correspondence will only be made on the present address of the candidates. BSF will not be responsible for any postal delay or wrong delivery.

NOTE-I : Final scrutiny of eligibility criteria with regards to age, educational qualification, caste, physical standard will be undertaken at the time of final selection/medical examination. Therefore, candidature will be accepted only provisionally till final selection. At the time of final selection when scrutiny is undertaken and if any claim made in application is not found substantiated then the candidature will be cancelled and the decision of BSF in this regard shall be final.

2. AGE DETERMINATION AND RELAXATION

(a) The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Lakshadweep) i.e. 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in the 'Employment News'.

(b) Candidates should note that only the Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate or an equivalent certificate available on the date of submission of application will be accepted by the BSF for determining the age eligibility and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.

4. DEFINITIONS/CONDITIONS FOR EX-SERVICEMEN

An 'Ex-Servicemen' means a person :-

- i) Who has serviced in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy, Air Force of the Indian Union, and
 - a) Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; or
 - b) Who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or
 - c) Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment;

or

- ii) Who has released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

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or

- iii) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

or

- iv) Personnel who were on deputation in Army Postal service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987;

or

- v) Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army;

or

- vi) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

NOTE-I : *Character certificate : Minimum requirement will be 'Good' category certificate.*

NOTE-II : *All Ex-Servicemen are not required to undergo Physical Standard Test (PST) and Physical Efficiency Test (PET). However, all Ex-Servicemen are required to pass the Written Examination, Documentation, Interview and Medical Examination.*

NOTE-III: *The SC, ST & OBC candidates selected against the vacancies reserved for ex-servicemen shall be adjusted against vacancies reserved for SC, ST and OBC respectively. In case reserved vacancy for Ex-Servicemen remained unfilled due to non availability of eligible or qualified candidates, the same shall be filled by candidates from non-ex-servicemen category*

5. **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

The selection procedure will be as follows:-

- (a) Written Examination.
- (b) Documentation and Physical Measurement.
- (c) Physical Efficiency Test.
- (d) Trade Test.
- (e) Interview and Medical Examination.

Selection procedure will be held in two phases which are as under:-

(A) **First Phase**

(i) **Written Examination**

The written examination will be conducted at the selection centres which will be communicated separately. There will be one composite paper for two hour duration from respective discipline and will be **“OBJECTIVE TYPE WITH MULTIPLE CHOICE”**.

Note:- (i) *Candidates are not permitted to use Mobile Phone, Calculator or any other electronic/electrical device for answering any paper (Test Booklets). Candidates must not, therefore, bring Mobile Phone, Calculator or any other electronic/electrical device inside the Examination premises. Possession of these items, whether in use or not, will be considered as “use of unfair means” in the Examination and appropriate action will be taken.*

(ii) *Discrepancies in Question Paper, if any, may be brought to the notice of the selection board in writing immediately on completion of holding the examination. Representation submitted subsequently will not be considered.*

(B) **Second Phase**

Second Phase as follows:-

(i) **Documentation and Physical measurement**

(ii) **Physical Efficiency Test**

Candidates are required to qualify following events:-

- (a) 1 Mile Race - 08 Minutes
- (b) High Jump - 3 Feet 06 Inches (03 attempts)
- (c) Long Jump - 11 Feet – (03 attempts)

NOTE :- *Ex-Servicemen are not required to undergo PST/PET.*

(iii) **Trade Test (in respective trade)**:- Only qualifying in nature.

(iv) **Interview**

Candidates who score minimum qualifying marks in the written test and qualified in documentation, PST, PET and Trade Test be given chance to appear for Interview and personality test before board of officers. The break-up of marks for conduct of interview is as under:-

Physical Make-up - 05 Marks

The General personality of the candidate, his posture smartness & personality.

General Intelligence aptitude, Interest & - 10 Marks
Professional Skill

For Professional skill-Questions may be put up to the candidates in the field of respective discipline and related to their specific charter of duties. (simple questions may be put up to the candidates in his own field as well as matters of interest to test his awareness and understanding).

Behavioural aspects and Psychological - 05 Marks

The main aim under this head would be to find out if the candidate has any behavioral short comings like signs of short temper, casual approach, nervousness when cornered, stammering, stuttering etc).

Any conspicuous achievements 05 Marks

- a) Participation in University / State level /Inter Ftr Games : 04 Marks
- b) Participation in National level tournament : 05 Marks
- c) NCC "B" Certificate : 04 Marks
- d) NCC "C" Certificate : 05 Marks

Total : 25 Marks

(v) **Medical Examination**

Candidates who secure minimum qualifying marks in the interview will be subjected to medical examination so as to assess their fitness for appointment in BSF as per laid down standards. The medical examination will be held immediately after completion of interview at the respective centres. Medical standards are as follows:-

- (a) Vision :Minimum distant vision 6/6 and 6/9 both eyes without correction (i.e. without wearing glasses);
- (b) High grade colour vision;
- (c) Should not have knock-knees, flat feet, varicose vein or squint in eyes or any defect or deformity likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties in the Force.
- (vi) Candidates will be allowed to appear for next event only after qualifying the previous event.

NOTE:- The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all the stages of selection procedure will be purely provisional, subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, at any time before or after above selection procedure, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature will be cancelled by the department.

Note:- (i) A candidate must indicate the centres in the Application Form. A candidate must submit his application only to the concerned BSF office under whose jurisdiction the centre selected by him falls. Applications received in any other HQ of BSF other than the centres shown above will be rejected summarily.

(ii) BSF reserves the right to cancel any Centre and ask the candidates of that centre to appear from another centre. BSF also reserves the right to divert candidates of any centre to other Centre to take the examination.

(b) The last date of receipt of application in respect of candidates belonging to areas of North Eastern State, Ladakh division of J&K, Sikkim, Pangi Sub division of Chamba, Lahaul & Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar and Lakshdweep Islands is within 45 days from the date of publication of this Advertisement in 'Employment News'.

(c) The applications should be accompanied with attested copies of certificates of proof of age, education qualification, technical qualification, experience in trade, caste/hill areas (Domicile), wherever applicable. **Candidates are permitted to apply for only one post. 6. EXAMINATION FEE

Each application should be accompanied by a Demand Draft/Postal Order for Rs. 50/- (Fifty) as examination fee in favour of the addressee to whom the application is addressed, payable at respective SBI/Post Office at the location or nearby station. However, fee is exempted for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, BSF Candidates, Ex-Servicemen.

NOTE-I: *Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.*

NOTE-II: *Fee paid by **modes other than DD/IPO**, as stated above, will **not** be accepted and the applications of such candidates will be rejected forthright and the payment made shall stand forfeited.*

7 PAYMENT OF TA TO SC/ST CANDIDATES

Under the provisions contained in GOI's Order No.4 & 5 below SR 132 relating to the grant of traveling allowance to SC/ST candidates called for interview (Group 'B' and 'C' advertised posts) recruitment authority can re-imburse second class actual railway fare or Bus fare chargeable by the shortest route from Railway Station/Bus stand nearest to their normal place of residence or from which they actually performed the journey, whichever nearer to the place of residence or from which they actually performed the journey, whichever nearer to the place of interview and back to the same station, provided that the fare of the first 30 Kms in both cases (i.e. rail or road) is borne by the candidates and the re-imbursement restricted to the fare in respect of the balance of distance exceeding 30 Kms both ways. Extra charges if any incurred for reservation seat/sleeping berth in the train, will not be reimbursed to the candidates. For road journey between stations not connected by rail, the recruiting authority may allow such candidates actual bus fare or road mileage at the lowest rate for Govt. Servants as admissible under the SRs, whichever is less, provided the distance covered by road is more than 32 Kms each way.

The above concession is not admissible to those SC/ST candidates who are already in Central/State Govt corporations Public Undertakings, Local Govt Institutions and Panchayats. The expenditure involved on account of the payment of TA to the SCs/STs candidates called for interview to be treated as 'Contingent expenditure'. The concerned Selection Centre will be responsible for making the TA to SC/ST candidates at the spot after completion of interview. The concerned selection center will draw 100% advance in lump sum in respect of the affected candidates well in time for making payment to the candidates at the spot as per instructions on the subject. The proforma for claim of interview charges for recruitment of BSF Water Wing personnel is attached as **Annexure-'J'**.

In case of any doubt pertaining to recruitment/selection test, the case may be referred to this HQ for clarification.

8. CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

- i) Selected candidates will be liable to serve anywhere in the Union of India or abroad.
- ii) Candidate will be governed by BSF Act & Rules as amended from time to time.
- iii) The new defined contribution pension system is applicable for all new entrants to the Central Govt Service on or after 01 Jan 2004.
- iv) Selected candidates will have to undergo basic training and such other courses as prescribed in the Force from time to time.
- v) The posts are Combatized and selected candidate will be governed under provision of BSF Act and Rule.

9. BSF'S DECISION FINAL

The decision of the BSF in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s) and interviews, allotment of examination centres and selection will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

10. COURT JURISDICTION

Any dispute in regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts/tribunals having jurisdiction over the city/town in which the concerned centre/office of BSF is situated and where the candidate has submitted his application.


