Course: B.Sc. Nursing

Duration: Four Years

1. General information:

Admission to B.Sc. Nursing course will be strictly on the basis of rank/merit obtained in GNET-2014

Total Seats = 35

UT Pool (85%):- Chandigarh Administration's circular No. 19/1/93/IH (3-99/11136) dated 9th June, 1999 provides that 85% seats of the total sanctioned intake of an institution will be filled up from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from schools/colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, as regular students of the said school/college.

General Pool (15%):- Remaining 15% seats will be filled from amongst students, who passed their qualifying examination from institutions other than those located in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, or otherwise.

Important Note:

- a. In calculation of percentage of seats for reserved category/categories the figure has been rounded off to lower whole number if decimal point is less than 0.5 and to higher whole number if the decimal point is 0.5 or more.

3. Eligibility criteria:

- i) Candidate must be citizen of India.
- ii) The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- iii) **Minimum Educational Qualification**

- a) Candidates should have passed 10+2 class with Science (PCB) & English Core/English Elective with aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for Scheduled Castes (SC) candidates from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board.
- b) Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School will also be eligible provided they secure aggregate of 45% marks for General category and 40% marks for SC candidates. However he/she shall not be eligible for admission, if he/she does not pass the qualifying examination with the required pass percentage of marks prior to the first round of Counseling. He/she will be allowed to attend first counseling only if detailed marks certificate of the above said examination is submitted prior to or at the time of first counseling, failing which he/she will be declared ineligible for admission year 2014 and his/her application will be rejected.
- iv) ***Admission to B.Sc. Nursing course will be strictly on the basis of rank/merit obtained in Government Medical College & Hospital Nursing Entrance Test 2014 (GNET-2014)***
- v) Candidate shall be medically fit.

4. Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh, Nursing Entrance Test 2014 (GNET-2014)

- i) ***GNET-2014 will be held on 24.08.2014 from 10.00 am to 12.00 noon.***
- ii) Syllabus will be of 10+2 standard equivalent to AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE.
- iii) The medium of entrance test will be English only.
- iv) Paper will consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) as below:
 - a) Biology- 30 Questions
 - b) Physics- 10 Questions
 - c) Chemistry- 10 Questions
- v) Each question will carry 2 marks (maximum marks 100)
- vi) There will be no negative marking.
- vii) The minimum qualifying marks in GNET-2014 for inclusion in the list of successful candidates are as below:
 - a) ***General category: not less than 45%***
 - b) ***SC category: not less than 40%***
- viii) Result will be displayed on GMCH website **gmch.gov.in** on 26.08.2014 by 5.00 pm.

5. Procedure for applying for GNET-2014 examination cum admission:

- i) ***Candidate has to fill application form online available at GMCH website: gmch.gov.in***
- ii) ***Candidate has to fill only one online application form. No additional form is to be filled after declaration of GNET-2014 result.***
- iii) Before applying candidates are advised to go through the admission notice and the instructions carefully, published in the newspaper/brochure and then fill in the online application form.
- iv) Category of reservation should be entered in the prescribed column of the online application form.
- v) No addition of category of reservation will be allowed once form has been submitted.
- vi) Printout of submitted online application accompanied by self-attested photocopies of all relevant documents as below must be submitted either personally or reach by registered post by 14.08.2014, 4.00 pm:
 - a) Date of birth certificate.
 - b) 10th passing certificate.
 - c) Passing certificate of 10+2 examination.
 - d) Detail marks sheet of 10+2 examination.
 - e) Reserved category certificate issued by the competent authority.
 - f) Character certificate.
 - g) Demand draft for prescribed application fee of Rs.500/- for General Category and Rs.250/- for reserved category in the name of ***Director Principal, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector- 32, Chandigarh***, payable at Chandigarh.
 - h) The printout of the submitted online application form alongwith annexures in a sealed envelope, with top of the envelope clearly labeled “**APPLICATION FOR B.Sc. NURSING COURSE**” must be submitted either personally or reach by registered post by 14.08.2014, 4.00 pm at following address:

viii) GNET-2014 examination:

- a) GNET-2014 will be held on 24.08.2014 from 10.00 am to 12.00 noon.
- b) Admit card can be downloaded from the GMCH website gmch.gov.in from 21.08.2014 onwards.**

- d) **Venue of GNET-2014:** Venue of entrance test will be notified along with the Admit card and on GMCH website.
- e) Candidate should report at the entrance test venue by 9.30 am with following:
 - I. Downloaded Admit card pasted with photograph attested by a gazetted officer.**
 - II. Any one of the following photo identification proofs:**
 - a. Passport.
 - b. Driving license.
 - c. Voter identity card.
 - d. Any other document, such as PAN card, Aadhaar card etc., issued by government agency
 - f) Result will be displayed on GMCH website gmch.gov.in on 26.08.2014 by 5.00 pm

Important Note:-

- a. Printout of online application forms received after 14.08.2014 by 4.00 pm shall not be entertained under any circumstances, whatsoever, regardless of the fact whether the application is sent by post or through courier or by any other means. The GMCH-32, Chandigarh does not take any responsibility for any postal delay or delay in delivery by courier or by any other means or for loss in transit of the Print out online application form.
- b. Mere submission of application does not make a candidate eligible for admission to the course. It will be subject to eligibility criteria laid down for the course.
- c. No changes i.e. addition/deletion will be allowed in the print out of online application form after its submission.
- d. No admission into the examination hall will be allowed after 10.00 am.

6. Criteria for selection:

- i) The selection will be made on the basis of rank/merit obtained in the GNET-2014 entrance test to be conducted by Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.
- ii) There are no marks for counseling.
- iii) **Inter-se-merit:** If two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the GNET-2014 then the inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:-
 - a) Candidate with higher marks in biology in 10+2 examination will be senior in rank.
 - b) If the marks obtained in Biology in 10+2 examination are same then a candidate senior in age shall rank higher to the candidate who is younger in age.

7. Counseling:

- i) List of qualified candidates according to their rank/merit in GNET-2014 in their respective pool/general category/reserved category will be displayed on notice board and Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh on 26.08.2014 by 5.00 pm.
- ii) All qualified UT Pool/General Pool candidates will be considered for admission against General category seats in their respective pool according to their rank/merit in the combined list of their respective pool, in addition to the category they have applied for.

Important Note:

- a. Candidates belonging to reserved category, who obtain admission in the General category on the basis of their rank/merit in the GNET-2014, shall not be counted towards the seats for the reserved category concerned.
- iii) Candidates have to appear in person for counseling on 29.08.2014 in the office of the Director Principal, GMCH-32, Chandigarh.

Important Note:

- a. No separate counseling letter will be issued.
- b. No TA/DA will be paid for attending counseling.
- c. Mere attending counseling for a course doesn't confer any right to admission in that course. Admission will be strictly according to the rank/merit in GNET-2014
- iv) Personal appearance of the candidate before the Counseling/Admission Committee is mandatory for claiming seat as per rank/merit determined and displayed.
- v) Sequence of counseling will be for General category seats first, followed by Reserved category seats.
- vi) If a qualified candidate reports late for counseling when his/her turn according to his/her rank/merit has already been passed over, he/she will be considered as per available seats at the time of his/her actual reporting in the counseling.
- vii) Second counseling will be conducted for the vacant seats, if any. Information to this effect will be displayed on notice board and Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.
- viii) An otherwise qualified candidate who did not appear in the first counseling is allowed to appear in the second counseling and will be offered the available seat as per his/her rank/merit in the second counseling.
- ix) There will be no automatic transfer from Reserved category to General category at the time of second counseling if such a candidate is found eligible for admission in General category according to his/her rank/merit. At second counseling such a candidate, admitted against Reserved category in first counseling, must personally appear before the Counseling/Admission Committee for claiming seat in General category as per his/her rank/merit determined and displayed.
- x) At second counseling a waiting list, according to the rank/merit of candidates who appeared in this counseling, will be prepared for filling up the seats which may fall vacant before the closing date for admission. Information to this effect will be

displayed on notice board and Website of Government Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh.

xi) In case of non-availability of qualified SC candidates in UT Pool/General Pool, these seats will be filled from qualified General category candidates from respective Pool.

xii) The candidates should report at the counseling venue with any one of the following photo identification proofs:

- a) Passport.
- b) Driving license.
- c) Voter identity card.
- d) Any other document, such as PAN card, Aadhaar card etc., issued by government agency

xiii) The candidates should bring with them the following original documents alongwith two passport size photographs at the time of counseling:

- a) GNET-2014 Admit card.
- b) Date of birth certificate.
- c) 10th passing certificate.
- d) Passing certificate of 10+2 examination.
- e) Detail marks sheet of 10+2 examination.
- f) Reserved category certificate issued by the competent authority.
- g) Character certificate.
- h) Any other document as applicable.

Important Note:

- a. Attested copies of the certificates or similar other documents will not be entertained for granting admission to a candidate.

8. Admission

- i) The selected candidates will have to undergo medical examination by the constituted Medical Board on the same day or succeeding day of counseling. Candidates found medically fit shall be granted admission.
- ii) The candidates who do not appear before the Medical Board or are found medically unfit shall not be allowed to join the course.
- iii) Fees are to be paid on the day of medical examination after candidate is found medically fit. The candidature of the eligible candidates, who do not deposit the prescribed fees in full, shall stand automatically cancelled and vacancies so caused shall be offered to the candidates next in order of merit. No correspondence or appeal in this connection will be entertained by the Admission Committee.
- iv) Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the rules/criteria mentioned in this brochure. However, in all matters which need interpretation or for which no provision exists in the brochure, the decision of the Admission Committee shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained regarding rejection or disqualification of any candidate.
- i) The original certificates of the selected candidates will be retained by the college. The original certificates of the selected candidates shall be returned only if the seat is surrendered in writing by the candidate.
- ii) In case the information furnished or certificates/documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake or is found to have withheld or concealed information in the application form, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and the fee deposited shall be forfeited. In addition he/she may also face legal action under the law of the land.
- iii) All admissions to B.Sc. Nursing course shall be provisional and subject to the approval by Panjab University and Indian Nursing Council.
- iv) All legal disputes relating to admission of students will be subject to courts having jurisdiction in Chandigarh.

Important Note:

- b. Any directions/order governing admissions to the course from the Government/Hon'ble courts/Regulatory bodies will be binding on all candidates.

- c. The Rules and Regulations, including fee to be charged, are subject to revision and amendment from time to time and the revised decision will be applicable irrespective of those given in this brochure.

9. Fees:

- i) Selected candidates will have to pay fee and other dues as below:

- ii) The annual fee can be deposited, in cash, or through demand draft in favour of **Director Principal, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector -32, Chandigarh**, payable at Chandigarh.

10. Other Information:

- i) **Medium of teaching/instructions will be English**

ii) **Hostel:**

- a) Selected candidates will be provided hostel accommodation if available. Students who are allotted hostel accommodation are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of hostel failing which disciplinary action will be initiated.
- b) Student allotted hostel accommodation is liable to pay room rent/electricity/water charges as applicable from time to time.

- iii) **Mess:** Students can avail mess facility if available.

- iv) **Library:** There is a well-stocked library with all essential professional books, journals and magazine etc.

- v) **Students' Health:** The services of Government Medical College & Hospital will be available to the students during the time of illness.

- vi) **Counseling and Guidance:** Students' personal problems will be looked into and necessary counseling and guidance will be given by the teachers. The students are free to approach faculty members for the purpose.

- vii) **Sports and Recreation:** Facilities are available on as well as off the campus.

viii) Prevention of Ragging: Ragging is a cognizable offence. Stern action against the offenders shall be taken. Anyone involved in ragging will be punished in accordance with the law.
