- (iii) Matriculation with Hindi/Sanskrit or 10+2/B.A./M.A. with Hindi as one of the subject; and
- (iv) Certificate of having qualified State Teacher's Eligibility Test (STET)/ Haryana Teacher's Eligibility Test (HTET)/National Eligibility Test (NET). Further, the

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condition of STET/HTET will not be applicable in the subjects of Music and Fine Arts; and

- (v) Proficiency in teaching in English and Hindi medium; and
- (vi) Consistent good academic record; and
- (vii) Conversant in IT skills and effective use of new technologies as tools for learning.
- (viii) In case of PGTs, in the subjects of English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Economics, Geography, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Commerce, Music, and Fine Arts, the candidates who have qualified National Eligibility Test (NET), condition of B.Ed./M.Phil. will not be applicable.

M.A. Hindi with at least 55% marks from recognized university.

4 (g): 13 posts of PGT History

M.A. History with at least 55% marks from recognized university.

4 (h): 9 posts of PGT Political Science

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M.A. Pol. Science with at least 55% marks from a recognized university.

4 (i): 7 posts of PGT Economics

M.A. Economics/ Applied Economics/Business Economics with at least 55% marks from recognized university.

4 (j): 19 posts of PGT Geography

M.A. Geography with at least 55% marks from recognized university.

4 (k): 10 posts of PGT Biology

M.Sc. Zoology/Botany/ Bio-Science/Genetics/Micro-Biology/ Plant Pathology/ Biotechnology/Environmental Science/ Life Science/ Molecular Bio. with at least 55% from recognized university marks, provided that the applicant had studied Botany & Zoology at Graduation level.

Qualifying Tests:

I. Clerk

A written test will be conducted for the posts of Clerk. The written test will comprise of Multiple Choice Questions for maximum of 50 marks in General knowledge, Mental ability (Reasoning &Quantitative Technique), Hindi (Matric level) & English (Matric level). The shortlisted candidates, as per the written test, will be required to pass a type test as per the qualification norms mentioned above, before document verification. 

No. 5: Pay Scale: The incumbent appointed will be paid

- i) The entry level pay will be Rs. 7580/- for the post of Clerk and Accounts Clerk; Rs. 6050/- for the post of Lab Attendant and Rs. 16890/- for the post of PGTs.
- ii) He/She will be paid Medical Allowances, DA and HRA as per rules
- **No. 6:** Application Fee: Application fees (non-refundable) amounting toRs.500/-+Rs.20 (Bank charges) for General and other category candidates and Rs.250/- Rs.20 (Bank charges) for SC/PH candidates of Haryana state will be payable through challan, generated after online filling of application.

Note: Candidates belonging to other reserved categories (SC/BC/ESM/PHC candidates of Haryana State) must ensure that they have valid caste certificate issued by the competent authority. In case, at the time of verification of documents, it is found that certificates are not valid, their candidature will be rejected.

No. 7: Consistent Good Academic Record means that out of the lower qualifications i.e. Graduation/10+2/Matric etc., other than the requisite minimum qualification, one must secure at least 55 % marks in one lower examination and 50% in the two lower examinations. If there are only two lower examinations, then one must have secured at least 55 % marks in one lower exam and 50% in another.

No. 8: Professional Training Diploma or Certificate awarded by any State, Board or University other than Haryana Education Department will be recognized only if this Degree or Diploma or Certificate has been recognized by the Haryana Government.

No. 9: A Diploma/degree course in teacher education recognised by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) only shall be considered. However, in case of Diploma in Education (Special Education) and B.Ed. (Special Education), a course recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) only shall be considered.

No. 10: 33% posts in each category shall be reserved for women and this reservation shall be horizontal.

No. 11: Candidates having qualified HTET/STET conducted by Haryana Board of School Education, Bhiwani for this category of teachers only will be eligible.
