    - (ii) One year's practical experience in the field of wireless communication (including installation & maintenance of wireless transmitter & receivers) or Aids to Navigation (including Visual and Radio Aids to Navigation), automatic relay systems or Diesel generator sets.

- ii) AGE LIMIT:
  - (a) The lower and upper age limit indicated will be reckoned as on 08.09.2014. The upper age limit is relaxable as under subject to submission of requisite certificate. - iv) RECRUITMENT PROCESS:
- Applications received will be scrutinized and short listed on the basis of marks obtained in the essential qualification (a) examination. The Short listed candidates will only considered for further recruitment procedures.
- (b) Written examination contains objective / descriptive type questions based on Diploma standard for the prescribed post.
- The Deputy Director General of Lighthouses & Lightships, as its discretion may hold additional skill test / interview if (c) consider necessary for all or for a limited number of candidates as may be deemed fit by Deputy Director General.

- The stage of examination is single stage examination followed by interview & verification of original documents. Based (e) on the performance of candidates in written examination the candidates will be called for the interview.
