

**Revised Scheme and Syllabus for tradesman/Industrial Employees -
tentative scheduled date of Written Examination - 21/09/2014
Against Advt. No. DAVP 10201/11/0324/1415 dated 24-30 May, 2014**

SCHEME:

1. There will be a written examination of one paper. The paper will be of "**Objective Multiple-choice-type**" of **maximum 100 marks**.

2. The paper will consist of two parts:

(a) PART -A will consist of 20 marks having questions on General Science and Quantitative Aptitude, each having weightage of 10 marks. The question will be of up to **10th Standard**.

(b) PART- B will consist of **80 marks of NCVT syllabus** for the relevant trade.

*For those trades which are not listed in NCVT Syllabus such as EXAM (ENGG), EXAM (GEN), EXAM (METAL), FITTER (AUTO ELECRIC), FITTER (AUTO), FITTER (ELEC), FITTER (ELECTRONICS), FITTER (INSTRUMENT), FITTER (PIPE), MILLER-Syllabus has been devised and candidates are requested to download the same from the **GIF, JABALPUR** website **www.gifofb.nic.in**.*

All the questions will be compulsory. **There will be no negative marking.**

The subject of the written examination, the maximum marks allotted to each paper, no of questions and the time allowed is given in the table below:-

Note:-

1. The paper would be bilingual, i.e. it would be printed in Hindi as well as English.
2. The paper would be required to be answered in OMR sheets.
3. Candidates would be required to darken the circles in the OMR sheet with **black pen**. OMR sheets marked in pencil would be rejected outright.
4. No marks would be allotted for questions in which multiple darkening has been done in the OMR Sheet.

SYLLABUS:

(A) General Science (10 Questions)

Question will be aimed at testing the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him. Question will also be designed to test knowledge of basic science studied up to 10th standard and would include such matters of every day observations and experience as may be expected of any educated person.

(B) Quantitative Aptitude (10 Questions)

The candidate will be tested for general mathematics of up to 10th Standard involving number system, equations in two variables, simple and compound interest, perimeter, area and volume of geometrical figures, Direct and inverse proportions, Pythagoras theorem and trigonometry.

(C) NCVT Trade (80 Questions)

Questions from the NCVT Syllabus of relevant trade, *if any otherwise available in the GIF, Jabalpur website **www.gifofb.nic.in**. The same may be downloaded from the said website.*
