Guidelines and Terms and Conditions for the Teaching Positions Advertised

1. Qualification and Experience

I) PROFESSOR

- An eminent scholar with a PhD in the concerned / allied / relevant discipline and having published work of high quality and actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 (ten) publications in refereed / peer-reviewed journals, and as books and / or research / policy papers.
- An eminent scholar with published work of high quality and actively engaged in research, with 10 years of experience in post-graduate teaching and/or research at the University/ National-level Institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.
- A minimum Academic Performance Indicator (API) scores under the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in the UGC Regulation 2010 and subsequently amended in 2013.

OR

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has a made significant contribution to the field of knowledge

II) PROFESSOR-CUM-PRINCIPAL

- A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) by a recognized University.
- A PhD Degree in concerned/allied/relevant discipline(s) in the institution concerned with evidence of published work and research guidance.
- Reader / Associate Professor/Professor with a total experience of fifteen years of teaching / research / administration in Universities, Colleges and other institutions of higher education.
- A minimum Academic Performance Indicator (API) scores under the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in the UGC Regulation 2010 and subsequently amended in 2013 for direct recruitment of Professors in Colleges.

III) READER

- Good academic record with a doctoral degree or equivalent published work. In addition, candidates who join from outside the University system, shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the seven point scale with latter grades, O, A, B, C, D, and E & F at the Master's Degree Level.
- A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution / Industry excluding the period of PhD research with evidence of published work and a minimum of five publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

- (c) A minimum Academic Performance Indicator (API) scores under the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), as set out in the UGC Regulation 2010 and subsequently amended in 2013.

IV) LECTURER

- (a) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian University/Foreign University.
- (b) Besides the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/NET. However, the candidates having M.Phil degree on or before 10 July 2009 shall remain exempted from the requirement of NET. Further, all candidates who have either obtained PhD degree on or before 31 December 2009 and candidates who had registered themselves for PhD degree on or before 10 July 2009 and subsequently awarded the PhD degree, shall remain exempted from the requirement of NET. (Candidates who had registered themselves for PhD degree on or before 10 July 2009 are required to enclose registration certificate with the application form).
- (c) Without prejudice to the above, NET / SLET / SET shall also not be required for such Master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET / SLET / SET is not conducted.

NOTE:

1. A relaxation of 5% of the marks at the master's level (from 55% to 50%) may be provided for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe / Persons with Disabilities category.
2. A relaxation of 5% of the marks (from 55% to 50%) may be provided to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. A relaxation of the minimum marks at the PG level from 55% to 50% for appointment as Lecturer may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF Examination conducted by UGC / CSIR only prior to 1989 when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF Examination were 50%.

4. How to apply

Interested candidates are required to visit www.utkaluniversity.ac.in to know the details of the terms and conditions including academic qualifications, specializations, reservation positions, salary and application submission procedures. Online applications may be filled in and submitted there in. The print out of the filled in online application should be sent along with the required documents to **the Registrar, Utkal University, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar – 751 004** by SPEED POST.

The envelopes containing the application should be superscribed **"APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____ IN SUBJECT _____"**

The last date of filling up online application form is 2400 hours of 5 November 2014. However, the last date of receipt of online printed application along with required documents is 12 November 2014.

5. Documents to be submitted along with application forms

- (a) Self attested photocopies of certificates and mark sheets of all examinations passed.
- (b) Self attested photocopies of certificates for claiming any types of reservations.
- (c) API score certified by the competent authority.
- (d) Proof of payment of application fee.
- (e) Photocopies of other achievements and research work.
- (f) Candidates who are in-service can send their applications as Advance Copy in order to save delay. They have to ensure that the 'proper channel' application will follow it.**
- (g) Candidates applying for the post of Reader are required to submit the reprints of their five major publications.
- (h) Candidates applying for the post of Professor are required to submit the reprints of their ten major publications.

5. Other Conditions

- (a) Candidate intending to apply for different posts are required to apply separately.
- (b) No TA/DA will be paid to attend the selection committee or to join the first appointment.
- (c) Canvassing in any form by or on behalf of the candidate will be considered as a ground for disqualification.
- (d) Applications received incomplete in any respect are liable to be summarily rejected and no correspondence on that score shall be entertained.
- (e) University reserves the right to amend/ alter/ cancel any or all conditions mentioned above, if necessary, without assigning any reason thereof.
