Logo Designing Competition: Rules and Prizes

- This competition is open to DRDO Employees only.
- There is no entry fee
- All logos must be submitted online by 11:59 pm on Nov 30, 2014.
- The image can be saved at a resolution that will enable us to zoom in to see details during judging, but the file size must not exceed 5MB. File formats: .gif, .jpeg, .png, .pdf; preferably in RGB color mode and emailed to us at drdoysm2015@gmail.com.
- Logo must be modern, simple, smart, recognizable and memorable.
- Logo must include the words, "Young Scientists Meet 2015".
- Entries must be entirely your own original work and must not breach any copyright or third party rights. DRDO will not be made partially or fully liable for any non-original work submitted by you.
- If you wish to enter this competition, you must provide us with your full name, current official address, mobile number and email address.
- Maximum two entries will be accepted per person. Entries cannot be returned, so remember to retain a copy.
- All entries will be judged on the following criteria: A strong, imaginative design which:
 - is modern
 - is dynamic and conveys a feeling of movement or change
 - is simple and can be reproduced easily on print/online
- Three Winners including one Readers' Choice will be chosen for the Prize by a Panel of Judges and the result will be announced on the DRDO Website.
- Winner will be notified via the telephone and e-mail. The decision of the judges for the Contest is final and no further claims will be entertained.
- Winners will be suitably rewarded.
- The Top 3 Logo Designs will be published in *DRDO Newsletter*.
- Results will be published on DRDO Website on/before 31 Dec 2014.
