Animals have their own unique ways of communication. In fact, animal communication is as diverse as the species of animals themselves. They are not capable of communicating through advanced language techniques, but often their ways of communication are far more intelligent than ours. They communicate for a variety of reasons; to attract mates, threaten rivals, warn about danger or share information about food sources.

Animal communication can broadly be divided into four different categories : visual, auditory, tactile and chemical. Visual communication is used to draw attention, attract mates and threaten others. Some animals send sound vibrations to others to transmit messages. This is known as auditory communication. Some others send information by actually touching other animal's body. This form is called tactile communication. Chimpanzees groom one another to strengthen their bond. The last form is through chemical or hormone secretion. This form of communication mainly relies on scent. Skunks use their signature smell to deter predators.
