What's in it for you?

An opportunity to influence some of the most prominent HR professionals through the white paper when you present it to them and have it published. You also get to present in person, to industry stalwarts at the *Future of Work conference* this year. You also win some cool prizes!

Here's how you can participate:

- This is a team contest and each team must have 2 members
- Both members should be under the age of 40

It's easy to submit your paper:

- 1. There will be 2 levels of the contest.
 - Teams need to register and send in participant's names to tanya@amchamindia.com by 12th March.
 - After that, participants need to submit an abstract and full length paper on a topic in either category A or B.
 - Winners will be invited to present at the HR committee's Future of Work conference on 10th April
- In the abstract, the team would be expected to define the problem scope, the suggested/applied solution, the success criteria and a closure statement. Abstracts should not be more than 350 words
- The full length paper should be on the basis of the abstract. One team can submit only one abstract and one paper.
- Papers must be sent as per the format described below:
 - a. The paper must be typed and should not exceed 2000 words.
 It has to be original and being presented for the first time.
 - b. Use Times New Roman 12size font with 1-line spacing

- Team members should be from the same organization
- Participating organization must be a member of AMCHAM

A few things to keep in mind during your submission:

- The cover page should include your name, designation, organization's name and contact details for both the abstract and the final paper.
- 2. The team should indicate if one or both of them are millennials.

- The last date for submission of the abstract and paper is 24th March, 2017 to tanya@amchamindia.com
- Participants will be informed of their selection by 31st March, 2017 & will be invited to present their paper at the Future of Work Seminar. Winners would be awarded the prizes on the day of the presentation.
- The papers will be evaluated by a committee of eminent subject matter experts in the Industry. Their decision shall be final and binding.
