1.	Application for JELET-2017 has to be done online only. There is no printed application form.
2.	Ensure that you are filling genuine application form available on line at www.wbjeeb.in
3.	It is essential to have a unique mobile number and a unique email ID. All future communications will be received from and sent to the registered mobile number and email ID. Communications from candidates from any other mobile number or email ID cannot be considered genuine/official and hence are liable to be ignored. WBJEEB will not be responsible for non-receipt of any communication by the candidates if the mobile number and/or the email ID are found wrong/non-existing/changed.
4.	Candidates are advised to study the Guidelines of Online Application thoroughly before attempting online application.
5.	Once the registration details i.e. candidate's name, father's name, mother's name, date of birth, mobile number and email ID are entered and submitted, they cannot be changed/modified/edited under normal circumstances. Also the information must match exactly with the school 10th standard admit cards, mark sheets, certificates, photo identity cards, caste/category certificates etc. which the candidate have to produce when entering the examination hall, during counselling, during admission & during registration with the University. In case of any unfortunate mistake committed by the candidate in filling up the online application form, he/she may visit the Board's office with original documents for correction, but within the last date of online application.
6.	Do not attempt to make any duplicate application.
7.	Do not share your application number; pass word, security question/answer with anyone.
8.	Upload scanned copy of photograph, signature and left thumb impression only as described in the Information Bulletin.
9.	If you receive any SMS/email regarding discrepancy in the photograph/signature/LTI uploaded by you, take corrective action immediately within one day and by the last date and hour of online application.
10.	The amount of application fees to be paid for appearing in the JELET-2017 is ₹500 (Rupees five hundred only) plus Service Charges as applicable. The Examination Fees can be paid in cash less mode by 'Net Banking' / 'Debit Card' / 'Credit Card' or in cash using Allahabad Bank e-challan. Payment status is updated online and hence should show 'OK' immediately after the payment. But in some rare cases it may be delayed due to the Bank's network delay/failure or transaction failure at the Electronic Payment Gateway (EPG). If the payment status does not show 'OK' immediately after making the payment then the candidates are advised as

	follows, a) If the payment was made by e-challan, contact the bank branch immediately, where the cash payment was made. b) If the payment was made by net banking/debit card/credit card, and the transaction failed at EPG, the candidate has to make payment once again. 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1.0	Introduction: The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board (WBJEEB) was constituted in the year 1962 by the State Government of West Bengal, in exercise of the powers conferred under article 162 of the Constitution of India in pursuant to No. 828-Edn(T), dated 02.03.1962 for the purpose of conducting Joint Entrance Examination for admission to various institutions in West Bengal imparting education in medical, engineering and technological courses. The endeavour of the Board has always been directed towards enhancement of transparency in conducting Common Entrance Examinations for various professional Undergraduate and Postgraduate level courses in the State through effective state-of-the-art technology. The Board has been awarded the status of Statutory Body enacted vide ‘West Bengal Act XIV of 2014’ named as ‘The West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations Board Act, 2014’. The Board is empowered to conduct common, combined, competitive, entrance examinations for admission to the Undergraduate Professional and Vocational Courses in any College or in any University in the State of West Bengal. 2.0	JELET-2017
2.1	For 2017–2018 academic sessions, the Board will conduct common entrance examination titled JELET-2017 for admission into 2 nd year (3 rd semester) of four year Bachelor Degree courses in Engineering/ Technology/ Pharmacy (except Architecture) in Universities, Government Colleges as well as Self Financing Engineering & Technological Institutes in the State of West Bengal.
2.2	Schedule of JELET-2017: 11th June (Sunday), 11:00 a.m to 1:00 p.m. No further examination shall be held under any circumstances for those who will be unable to appear on the above scheduled date and time of JELET-2017 examination.
2.3	Pattern of Question Papers. The paper will contain fifty (100) MCQ (Multiple Choice Question) type questions, with four answer options each. Each question carries 1 mark, full mark of the paper is 100 and duration of the test is 2 hours. The questions will be in English language only. The paper consists of various sections depending on the qualifying examination the candidate has passed. The detail is given in the table below.

2.6	Scoring Methodology a) All questions will have four answer options b) Only one option is correct. c) Correct response will yield 1 (one) mark. d) Incorrect response will yield -1/4 (25% negative) marks. e) For any combination of response with more than one option, the said answer will be treated as incorrect and will yield -1/4 (25% negative) marks f) No response will yield zero mark.
2.7	Ranking Methodology and publication of Merit Lists WBJEEB will publish following five separate merit rank lists based on the candidates' total score in the entrance test. - Merit rank for Diploma holders in Engineering & Technology except Printing Technology and Agricultural Engineering. - Merit rank for Diploma holders in Printing Technology. - Merit rank for Diploma holders in Agricultural Engineering. - Merit rank for Diploma holders in Pharmacy. - Merit rank for B. Sc. Candidates. a) This Lists shall be in the name and style of 'GMR' (General Merit Rank) b) Separate reserved category merit rank shall also be published for respective category of students e.g. SC Rank, ST Rank, OBC-A Rank, OBC-B Rank, PwD Rank. c) But only 'GMR' shall be applicable for sequencing the counseling and seat allotment. d) Ranking of the said Merit Lists shall be done in the descending order of total marks scored in the entrance test. e) However, there may be ties and following tie-breaking rule shall be applicable for them in determination of their merit rank.

3.0	Eligibility and academic qualification criteria for appearing in JELET-2017
3.1	Eligibility criteria for appearing in JELET-2017: a) Citizenship: Applicant must be a citizen of India. b) Age Restriction: I. There is no upper age limit for Diploma holders in Engineering/ Technology/ Pharmacy. II. For B. Sc. Candidates, the upper age limit is 27 (twenty seven) years as on 31.12.2017. III. For Diploma holders in marine Engineering, the upper age limit is 25 (twenty five) years as on 31.12.2017
3.2	Eligibility criteria for admission: a) Diploma holders seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course: i. The candidate must pass Diploma in engineering/ Technology from an AICTE approved institution with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks or equivalent CGPA.

	ii. All relevant norms of D. G. Shipping will be applicable for admission into Degree Course in Marine Engineering. b) B. Sc. candidates seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course: I. The candidate must pass B. Sc. Degree from any University recognised by UGC with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks II. Also the candidate must have passed 12th standard school examination with Mathematics as a subject. III. The candidate, if admitted, will have to clear the subjects of Engineering Mechanics and Engineering Graphics / Engineering Drawing of the 1st year Degree Course in Engineering/Technology along with their second year subjects. IV. B.Sc. candidates will be considered for admission only if vacancies remain even after filling the seats with available Diploma holder candidates. V. B. Sc. Candidates are not eligible for admission into Degree Course in Pharmacy. c) Both Diploma holder and B. Sc. Candidates seeking admission into Engineering & Technology Degree Course: Both such candidates will also be eligible for admission to the 1st year Engineering Degree Courses subject to vacancies in the 1st year classes in case the vacancies as lateral entry at second year are exhausted. However, the admission shall be based strictly on the eligibility criteria as mentioned above. d) Diploma holders in Pharmacy seeking admission into Degree Course in Pharmacy: e) The candidate must pass Diploma in Pharmacy from an AICTE approved institution with at least 45% (40% for SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/ PwD) marks or equivalent CGPA. f) Such candidates will also be eligible for admission to the 1st year Degree Course subject to vacancies in the 1st year classes in case the vacancies as lateral entry at second year are exhausted. However, the admission shall be based strictly on the eligibility criteria as mentioned above. g) Special criteria for admission in Jadavpur University through lateral entry: B. Sc. Degree holders are not eligible for admission in Jadavpur University through lateral entry. The Diploma holder candidates also must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination before their Diploma Course.
3.3	Important information to candidates regarding eligibility WBJEEB do neither verify the information provided by the candidate during online application nor verify any certificate of date of birth, domicile, income, reservation category, academic qualification etc. for deciding the eligibility of the candidate. Admit cards issued only on the basis of the information provided by the candidate. Also there is no scope of changing/correcting any information after the last date of online application. All verifications are done during counselling/admission by concerned authorities and finally by the concerned university, where registration will be done. If at any stage after examination it is found on scrutiny that the applicant is otherwise ineligible, his/her candidature shall be treated as cancelled even if he/she secured a Merit Rank in the JELET-2017. Hence securing a Rank in the JELET-2017 does not constitute a right/guarantee in favour of a candidate for his/her claim for admission who ultimately fails to comply the

	Note: As per approved Calcutta University Regulation of B. Tech. in Jute & Fibre Course of Calcutta University, it is mentioned that for Lateral Entry admission to 2nd year (3rd semester) of B. Tech. in Jute Technology Course of Calcutta University, candidates with Diploma in Mechanical Engg. or Electrical Engg. or Chemical Engg. or Computer Engg. or Electronics Engg or Textile Technology or Textile (Handloom Technology) or Apparel/Fashion Technology or passed B. Sc. 2-year P.G. Diploma in Jute Technology/ Jute Technology and management or B. Sc. In Textile and Clothing Science or Bachelor of Fashion Design or B.Sc. (with Physics, Chemistry and mathematics) from any institute/College or equivalent as recognised by the University of Calcutta and qualified through JELET-2017 will be eligible.
5.0	Reservation: a) In respect of reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PwD, applicable Acts/Rules of the Government of West Bengal/ of the concerned University prevailing at the time of admission will be followed. SUCH RESERVATION IS AVAILABLE ONLY TO CANDIDATES DOMICILED IN WEST BENGAL. b) As the reservation for PwD (persons with disability) candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in General/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B category to which he/she belongs. c) List of such reserved seats will be announced by the concerned counselling authority before counseling.
6.0	Requirements in terms of Residential/Domicile Criteria a) There is no particular Residential/Domicile requirement to appear in the JELET-2017 admission test. b) However, the State (West Bengal) Residential/Domicile requirement is essential for admission in any Government College/Institution in any category of seats. c) Only in case of Diploma holders in Fashion Technology under Govt. Polytechnic Institutions from Tripura are eligible for admission to Degree level Apparel Production & Management Course and Textile Technology Course in Govt. College of Engineering and Textile Technology, Serampore and Berhampore under Lateral Entry Scheme with relaxation of (West Bengal) domicile criteria d) Also the State (West Bengal) Residential/Domicile requirement is essential for admission in any reserved category of seats in any college/institution. e) The candidate needs to download the required proforma as per the detail given in section 6.1 below and keep the certificate ready to be produced during counseling, admission etc. f) If any of the certificates is then found to be invalid, the candidate will lose the opportunity of admission.
6.1	Criteria to be treated as domicile of West Bengal and applicable proforma of certificate Only those candidates will be treated as domicile of West Bengal who are either, a) Residing in West Bengal continuously at least for last 10 (ten) years as on 31.12.2016.

	OR b) Whose parent(s) is/are permanent resident(s) of West Bengal having permanent address within the State of West Bengal. In case of a) above, the certificate is to be obtained in per forma 'a1' or proforma 'a2'. In case of b) above, the certificate is to be obtained in pro forma 'b'. Proforma 'a1' and 'b' are to be certified by government officials as detailed below and proforma 'a2' is to be certified by the Head of the Institution, wherefrom the candidate passed or appeared 10+2 level examination. The proformas are given in appendices.
6.2	Competent authority to issue domicile certificate A. Proforma 'a1' or 'b' must be signed and certified by any of the following competent authorities from Central Government or State Government <i>having local jurisdiction over the place of the permanent residence of the concerned candidate or his/her parents, as the case may be, viz.</i> - District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector, Sub – Divisional Officer, Block Development Officer. - Superintendent of Police, Additional Superintendent of Police, Sub Divisional Police Officer, Deputy Superintendent of Police, - Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate. - Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan locality or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. - Corporation Area - Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner. - Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat to the Government of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government. - Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Government of West Bengal or Central Government. B. Every official certifying the Domicile Status of the candidate or candidate's parents MUST provide his/her FULL NAME, DESIGNATION, PLACE OF POSTING WITH ADDRESS, LANDLINE/ MOBILE NUMBER. He/she should also provide his/her IDENTITY CARD NUMBER if available. C. CERTIFICATION FROM ANY AUTHORITY OTHER THAN THOSE THAT HAVE BEEN ENUMERATED ABOVE 'WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.' D.
